



❖ **STATEMENT OF COMPLIANCE** ❖
(Carpet and Resilient Flooring - Residential)

I have verified that the floor coverings in the dwelling noted below meet the requirements contained in Section 4.504 of the California Green Building Standards Code.

- 1) All interior carpeting and carpet pad meet one of the specified Green Label product criteria listed in of the California Green Building Standards Code, Section 4.504.3.***
- 2) All carpet adhesives meet the VOC limits established in the California Green Building Standards Code, Table 4.504.1.***
- 3) At least 50% of all resilient flooring areas comply with the VOC emission limits defined in the Collaborative for High Performance Schools (CHPS) Low-emitting Materials List or certified under the Resilient Floor Covering Institute (RFCI) Floor Score program or other standards listed in of the California Green Building Standards Code, Section 4.504.4.4.***
