On the above date and time, while assigned as a Field Operations Supervisor for the West NPC, I monitored a radio call of S/1 causing a disturbance reference him picking up his child. Dispatch advised S/1 was becoming aggressive and began assaulting people. Dispatch broadcasted that S/1 had possibly barricaded himself inside of classroom A-1 with a teacher. Upon my arrival, I went directly to the administration office and obtained a copy of the school map for reference. I then gathered breaching equipment from my assigned patrol unit and took it to the Emergency Response Team (ERT) located towards the front of classroom A-1.										Reviewed By [Signature] 1333
Once there, I assisted Sergeant Tipe with tactical preparations in regards to roles and responsibilities of the Emergency Response Team. I assumed the less lethal role by obtaining a 40mm less lethal launcher.										COPIES TO
Shortly after, additional METRO personnel arrived on-scene with the Armored Rescue Vehicle (ARV) and positioned it in-front of classroom A-1. 1 **Narrative Continued:**

2 Once inside classroom A-3, Officers Paes, Mowery, O'farrell, S. Lopez, Sergeant Tipre and I set up  
3 towards the center pod of the building and set up as a secondary Emergency Response Team.

5 Once Sergeant McCoy joined us in classroom A-3, the plan was to move into classroom A-6  
6 and deploy a surveillance camera in attempt of gathering intelligence on S/1 and V/1. After  
7 several hours of negotiations the tactical plan was to breach the interior accordion wall and  
8 make entry into classroom A-1 and rescue the victim.

10 Sergeant McCoy called for a diversion towards the front of the classroom, at which time, the  
11 interior accordion wall was breached. During the breach, I noticed the interior accordion wall  
12 opened approximately a foot and got stuck. The interior Emergency Response Team  
13 attempted to force open the accordion wall but were unsuccessful. I observed Officer Paes  
14 able to partially enter the opening of the breached accordion wall. At this time, I was  
15 positioned behind Officer's Paes and Mowery and heard Officer Paes verbalize, (what I recall  
16 being) "he has the victim". I then observed Officer Paes discharge his rifle approximately five  
17 times in the direction of where I believed the suspect was at.

19 At this point, the interior Emergency Response Team was still unable to fully breach the  
20 accordion wall and make entry. As the victim began crawling towards us, I assisted Officer  
21 Wilder and grabbed the victim and pulled her into classroom A-6. The victim was secured by  
22 unknown personnel located inside classroom A-6. I then broadcasted "failed breached" over  
23 the radio at which time the METRO team breached the front door and made entry. Officer  
24 Paes kept S/1 at bay by keeping him at gun point as METRO personnel approached S/1 and  
25 placed him into custody. Medical aid was summoned for S/1 and was shortly transported. I  
26 cleared from the classroom as the scene was secured.

28 During the incident I responded to the Magnolia Police Station in order to meet with the OIS  
29 investigators and got my weapons charted.
