Background:

On 10/31/17, I was assigned to the West Post-Release Accountability and Compliance Team (PACT), which consists of Officers and Deputies from multiple agencies throughout Riverside County. One of our duties is to conduct compliance checks of persons who are currently on Parole, Probation, Mandatory Supervision, Supervised Release and Post Release Community Supervision (PRCS).

Investigation:

On 10/31/2017, at approximately 1112 hours, I responded with assisting officers to *Castle View Elementary School* located at *6201 Shaker Drive, Riverside, CA. 92506* reference an assault in progress. While enroute to the call, I heard information that a male suspect had assaulted a teacher and had her barricaded with him in classroom A1. I heard further information that the suspect had possibly deployed some type of smoke in the classroom and possessed two backpacks (containing unknown items).

After arriving on scene, I was assigned to ERT #2 and took a position inside classroom A3. The A building has multiple classrooms with outward facing doors. The interior of the A building the classrooms have a shared common corridor, similar to that of a hexagon. I remained at the interior corridor door of A3, covering the interior corridor door of classroom A1. Officer Hill and Officer Zackowski were also assigned with me in classroom A3 as other officers from ERT#2 took a position in classroom A6.

As the breach command was given, I heard a light-sound diversionary device deploy towards the outer front area classroom A1. I could then hear ERT #2 personnel in classroom A6 attempting to breach a folding wall adjoining classrooms A1 and A6. After hearing failed breach, I saw Sergeant Ortiz exit classroom A6 with a battering ram and attempt to breach and gain access to classroom A1 from the interior corridor door. During this time, I moved into the center corridor to provide cover for Sergeant Ortiz. As Sergeant Ortiz was attempting to breach the door, I heard multiple gunshots coming from within classroom A1. Not knowing if the suspect was shooting and there still being a hostage inside, we remained at the door

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continuing to gain entry into the classroom. The initial breach of the door had been successful in disengaging the locking mechanism, but entry into the room was not possible, as the door had been barricaded from within. Sergeant Ortiz continued to attempt to gain access into classroom A1 until we heard the hostage had been removed from the classroom.

At this time, we moved into the interior corridor door of classroom A6 where I maintained cover of classroom A1 until advised the suspect was in custody. After clearing the classroom, all officers who were inside the classroom at the time of this incident were directed to respond to Riverside Police Department (Magnolia Station). Prior to leaving the outer perimeter of Castle View Elementary School, I removed the live round from my rifle and placed it back in the 30 round capacity magazine (loaded with 28 rounds). While at RPD Magnolia station, my firearms were charted by Detectives Smith, K. Corbett, and Anderson. After having my firearms charted and photographs taken, I was released from the station. Refer to the initial and supplemental reports for further details.

NOTE: During this incident I was equipped with my H&K USP 9mm handgun (s/n: 24-061537) and a Colt M4 Commando (s/n: A0272471).
