I am a Detective with the Riverside Police Department assigned to the Central NPC Investigations unit. On October 31st, 2017, I responded to Castleview Elementary School to assist with the barricaded subject.

NARRATIVE

10-31-17

At approximately 1134 hours, I responded to Castleview Elementary and was assigned to help maintain the security of the crime scene. I maintained that security position near the front office until I was assigned by Sgt. Miera to follow an AMR unit, which contained V/ Montgomery, to Riverside Community Hospital.

V/ Montgomery was transported to RCH by AMR unit #361 and we arrived at RCH at about 1812 hours.

Upon arrival to Riverside Community Hospital, I met with V/ Montgomery, who was visibly shaken; however, had no injuries except for a couple abrasions and bruises.

I stood by with V/ Montgomery until relieved by Sgt. Meira. Prior to leaving, I took photographs of V/ Montgomery and the abrasions to her knees. I used Officer McDonald's department issued camera to take the photographs.

I had no further action in this investigation.
