1 Narrative:

2 On 10-31-17 at about 1112 hours, I was working as a School Resource Officer at Poly High School. I
3 received a phone call from dispatch regarding an agitated parent at Castle View Elementary School. I
4 requested a back-up Officer via telephone. After I hung up with dispatch, they broadcasted the incident
5 over the radio and also dispatched a back-up Officer. As I was walking to my vehicle, dispatch advised
6 that the parent was 242ing a teacher and pulled a teacher inside of a classroom. I drove code 3 to Castle
7 View Elementary at this point. Upon arrival, 4 to 5 other Officers arrived at the same time. As we arrived
8 on the campus, W/Tiffany Farris (Principal) was standing to the front of the room where the suspect and
9 Teacher were. The suspect was later identified as S/Luvelle Kennon. The teacher was identified as
10 V/Linda Montgomery.

12 W/Farris was pointing at the classroom and telling us "They're in there". W/Farris was standing to the
13 front of building A and pointing to classroom A1. The additional Officers and I approached the front door
14 and prepared to make entry into the classroom. As I was standing near the front door, I could hear items
15 being thrown against the door. I also saw white smoke coming out from underneath the door. One of the
16 Officers looked through the window and stated that the entry way was blocked. I knew that there was a
17 secondary entry point through the rear of classroom, which was accessible from a common area in the
18 building. I had Officers hold on the front door while other Officers and I attempted to make entry through
19 the rear door. The additional Officers and I attempted to make entry through the rear door but we found
20 that it was also barricaded and we were unable to make entry.

22 At this point, I knew that S/Kennon and V/Montgomery were contained in the classroom and the rest of
23 the building was not occupied. As additional Officers arrived they set up in containment positions and we
24 established an Emergency Response Team (ERT) behind cover near the front door. Sgt. Lackey arrived
25 on scene and we established a rescue team to evacuate the rest of the campus. The campus was
26 successfully evacuated. A SWAT call out was initiated shortly after the incident began. I eventually
27 transitioned to a SWAT roll and became part of the ERT team as directed by the SWAT Commander. I
28 was assigned as the "Window breacher" on the window team. My responsibility was to "Port" two of the
29 windows located on the 1/4 side of the building that S/Kennon and V/Montgomery were located in. This
30 was to create a diversion and also cover for the entry team in the event that we had to perform a Hostage
31 Rescue.

33 After several hours, I heard over the radio that S/Kennon was no longer cooperating with Hostage
34 Negotiators. Shortly after, we were given the command by Sgt. Dehdashtian to initiate our Hostage
35 Rescue Operation. I ported two windows located on the 1/4 corner, using the "Break and Rake" tool. This
36 allowed for Officers Wright and Carmona to provide lethal and less lethal cover inside of the room. As I
37 was porting the second window, I heard 4 to 6 gun shots inside of the room. I could not see where the
38 shots were coming from and I did not know who (Officers or Suspect) was shooting at the time. I
39 transitioned to my pistol and attempted to locate the S/Kennon from the ported window in front. It was
40 dark in the room and there was smoke in the air due to a light and sound diversionary device being
41 deployed into the room. This made it very difficult to see into the room.

43 I used my tactical flashlight on my pistol to shine light into the room. Due to the smoke in the air, the
44 light refracted making it more difficult to see into the room. I was still unable to locate where S/Kennon
45 and V/Montgomery were. At some point, I heard "Failed breach" over the radio. I saw the secondary

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1 entry team make entry through the front door. I followed behind to assist in locating the S/Kennon and
2 V/Montgomery. I learned that V/Montgomery had been rescued by the initial ERT team and that
3 S/Kennon was located as well. At this time I learned that an OIS occurred. The scene was ultimately
4 rendered safe and secure. All personnel involved were directed to go to the Magnolia Station to be
5 interviewed. I was directed to write a supplemental report and cleared from the Magnolia Station at about
6 2200 hours.
