| 62. Narrative of Supplemental Report 62a. Audio Recording Available? No On 10-31-17, at approximately 1112 hours, Officer A. Soria and I were in an unmarked vehicle in the area of Central and Streeter. Dispatch broadcast a call stating a parent, S1 Kennon, of a student at Castle View Elementary was arguing with staff members at the front office. Dispatch also advised S1 Kennon took a teacher by the shirt, forced her into the classroom, and would not let her leave. S1 Kennon was possibly having a "PTSD episode". S1 Kennon was seen wearing camouflage attire and carrying two backpacks as he entered the classroom. Dispatch advised S1 Kennon possibly had military training as well. While enroute, the subject had barricaded room A1 and an Officer on scene broadcast smoke was coming from the classroom. Upon arrival, I parked on Shaker just south of the school and I saw several police vehicles on the street. I retrieved my rifle from the trunk of the vehicle and ran to the front of the school's south gate. As I ran into the school, I linked up with an ERT team just outside the multi purpose room. According to information gathered by Officer's first on scene, S1 Kennon and the victim (hostage) were the only people inside classroom A1. An Officer on scene mentioned blood was on the cement where we were set up. Dispatch advised S1 Kennon had battered teachers while on campus. The victim (hostage) was an elderly female teacher at the school.

I was approximately 20 yards away from classroom A1 and was assigned as lethal cover. While I was on ERT, evacuations of additional classrooms and school staff were taking place. I could see smoke in the air near the front of the classroom as I held lethal cover on the front of the classroom. I was then instructed to join up with METRO personnel, who had arrived in the ARV, on the west side of the school. Myself, as well as several additional METRO members, ran around the multi purpose room, down the stairs, to the lower portion of the school.

I entered the ARV, driven by Detective Serrato, who drove us to the front of the classroom. The ARV was positioned with the front end facing the classrooms front door, parked approximately 25 feet away. We were designated as ERT1 and roles and responsibilities were assigned. Non SWAT personnel were relieved of their positions. I was assigned as lethal cover on the rear passenger side of the ARV. I held lethal cover on the front windows to the front of the classroom. Officer Carmona and I took turns providing lethal cover from the rear passenger side of the ARV every few minutes.

A plan was made in case a crisis entry was needed. I was assigned as part of a three man team to approach the classroom front windows. Officer Carmona was assigned to break one of the classroom windows as I held lethal cover inside. Officer Glover was assigned to sight deploy a light sound and diversionary device inside the classroom if needed. At that time the entry team would breach the classroom front door.

After negotiations with the suspect and throw phone mission, a plan was made to make entry into the classroom. I was assigned as a four man window port team. The team was comprised of myself, Officer Carmona, Moulton, and Glover. I was assigned as lethal cover. We responded to the north side of classroom A1 and stood behind cover. We were instructed to move on the command of "divert". Once the command was given, we approached the windows from north to south. Officer Moulton used a clingon tool to break and clear the north window. As that happened, I held lethal cover from outside the classroom. I could see tables and chairs stacked up in the back of the room and it appeared S1 Kennon had barricaded the rear door. I did not see the suspect or victim from my vantage point. At that time, I heard "failed breach" broadcast over the radio. I then heard three or four gun shots as I held lethal cover, however, I could not see where they were coming from. Shots fired was broadcast over the radio.

At that point, ERT1 made entry through the front classroom door. Once they were inside, I left my position from holding lethal cover from the outside and joined ERT1. I helped clear the classroom in search of the suspect and victim (hostage). The classroom was filled with a smoke like substance. An officer in the classroom yelled the S1 Kennon was located near the collapsing wall. The victim (hostage) was rescued by ERT2 as entry was made. Once the classroom was clear, I learned an Officer involved shooting had occurred. Tactical medics were called to provide S1 Kennon medical aid.

I saw S1 Kennon laying on the classroom floor. Tactical Medic Vu entered the classroom and began providing medical aid. I cleared a walkway for AMR's stretcher by moving tables and chairs to the outer portion of the room. S1 Kennon was placed on a stretcher and taken out of the classroom. I met up with SWAT personnel on the north side of the main office where instructions were given by Lt. Dinco to respond to the Magnolia Station for further instruction.
