ASSIGNMENT:

On 10-31-17, I was working as a uniformed Riverside METRO Officer in full police uniform in the City and County of Riverside (State of California).

NARRATIVE:

At about 1112 hours, I responded to Castlevew Elementary School located at 6201 Shaker Dr. Riverside 92506 reference a report of V/Montgomery (a school teacher) being assaulted by S/Kennon. Prior to my arrival, dispatched advised that S/Kennon had assaulted V/Montgomery and then taken her hostage into a nearby classroom which he later barricaded. S/Kennon was last seen going into classroom A1 with V/Montgomery and two back packs.

S/Kennon was described as a Black male adult, approximately 27 years of age, tall with a thin build. He was last seen wearing a camouflage jacket and dark colored pants.

Upon arrival, Sgt. Dehdashtian assigned me to the Emergency React Team #1 in the ARV to the front of classroom A1. As part of the ERT Team, I was assigned as the window breacher to port the windows of the classroom in case a crisis entry was needed.

As the investigation continued Sgt. Dehdashtian developed a plan to conduct a deliberate assault of the classroom. While at the ARV, Sgt. Dehdashtian assigned me to the window port team along with METRO Officers Wright, Moulton and Glover. My assignment was to provide lethal cover for the primary assault team's entry (Sgt. McCoy's Team).

Prior to the deliberate assault METRO Officers Wright, Moulton, Glover and I rehearsed the window port mission. Following the rehearsal we staged to the front of classroom A6 which is just North of classroom A1 and awaited the command to initiate the window port mission.

After several hours, supervision requested that the assault be initiated. On Sgt. McCoy's command of divert, I moved to the first window to the front of classroom A1 (east side). Officer Moulton used a window breaching tool to break out the first window, I stuck my rifle into the classroom and began to provide lethal cover for the entry team.

As I looked into the classroom I could see that the lights were turned off, the room was filled with smoke, chairs and tables were barricaded along the front door, rear door and north side of classroom wall. I could not see S/Kennon or V/Montgomery. I then activated my weapons mounted light and gave commands for S/Kennon to show his hands but he did not show himself.

At that time, I could see the north side accordion wall begin to slide open and then stop. This is the primary entry point for Sgt. McCoy's Entry Team. I could not see the entry team members due to the chairs and tables stacked along the north side of the wall. I continued to give verbal commands and hold lethal cover for the entry team.

A short time later, Sgt. McCoy broadcasted "failed breach" over the radio. I then heard approximately four gunshots coming from the primary entry points location. I could not see a muzzle flash or tell who was shooting. I continued to provide lethal cover in the remainder of the classroom for the secondary entry team (as briefed). The secondary entry made entry and took S/Kennon into custody.

I then moved inside the classroom to clear a path for AMR personnel to render aid to S/Kennon.

Once the scene was cleared, we were briefed by Sgt. Dehdashtian to proceed to Magnolia Station for detectives. A short time later, Sgt. Dehdashtian advised the METRO Team to complete supplemental reports for the incident.
