Narrative of Supplemental Report:

On 10/31/17 at approximately 1748 hours, Sr. Forensic Specialist S. McKay-Davis and I were requested by Sgt. D. Warren to respond to Castle View Elementary located at the above listed address in reference to a kidnapping and officer involved shooting investigation. At approximately 1837 hours, we arrived at the location and met with Sgt. W. McCoy and homicide personnel who provided details of the incident. Sgt. M. Cobb, Det. M. Medici, and Det. J. Brandt assisted with processing the scene. I took 578 photographs of the scene. I assisted Det. Medici and Sr. Forensic Specialist McKay-Davis with measurements of the scene and evidence items (reference McKay-Davis' report for further). With the assistance of Det. J. Brandt, I collected evidence items BV002 through BV014, BV016 through BV021, and REA02 from classroom A1 and surrounding areas. At the direction of Det. M. Medici, evidence item BV015 was not collected and left at the scene since it was determined there was no evidentiary value. At approximately 0010 hours, I received evidence item PACT01 (electronic device and 16GB card) from Sgt. Cobb. At approximately 0027 hours, Sr. Forensic Specialist McKay-Davis and I cleared the location and I transported all evidence items to Magnolia Station. I placed all evidence items in the secured evidence vault and downloaded the photographs to the Digital Information Management System (DIMS).

On 11/2/17 at approximately 0908 hours, I removed PACT01 and BV020 from the secured evidence vault. I released BV020 to Det. Brandt at approximately 0920 hours. I then created a master copy DVD and a working copy DVD from the recorded video captured by evidence item PACT01. The master copy DVD was labeled PACT01A and the working copy DVD was labeled PACT01B. I released the electronic device of evidence item PACT01 and PACT01B to Det. Medici at approximately 1111 hours. At approximately 1415 hours, I removed BV003, BV007, BV009, and BV014 from the secured evidence vault. I took 72 photographs of the evidence items. Multiple areas of dry reddish-brown

stains were observed on evidence item BV007 (fire extinguisher). I collected sample swabs of possible blood from some of these areas labeled BV007A through BV007C. A reagent swab was collected and labeled REA01. A black colored head piece was located inside evidence item BV014 and separated as evidence item BV014A. I placed all remaining evidence items back inside the secured evidence vault at approximately 1610 hours.

On 11/3/17 at approximately 0948 hours, I removed evidence items BV003, BV007, BV007A through BV007C, BV009, BV014, BV014A, BV016, PACT01, PACT01A, and REA01 from the secured evidence vault. I released these evidence items to Magnolia Station property locker #32 at approximately 1127 hours. At approximately 1510 hours, I removed evidence items BV002, BV004 through BV006, BV008, BV010 through BV013, BV017 through BV019, BV021, and REA02 from the secured evidence vault. I took 21 photographs of evidence items BV002, BV006, BV010 through BV013, and BV021. A dry reddish-brown stain was observed on evidence item BV002 (scissors). I collected a sample swab of possible blood from this area labeled BV002A. A sample swab of possible DNA was also collected from another area on BV002 and labeled BV002B. A reagent swab was collected and labeled REA03. At the request of Det. Medici, BV002 was also processed for latent prints using Cyanoacrylate Fumes and Bi-Chromatic powder. No identifiable latent prints were observed or developed. I released evidence items BV002, BV002A, BV002B, BV004 through BV006, BV008, BV010 through BV013, BV017 through BV019, BV021, REA02, and REA03 to Magnolia Station property locker #37 at approximately 1727 hours. The photographs were downloaded to DIMS along with the photographs taken on 11/2/17.

No further action was taken.
