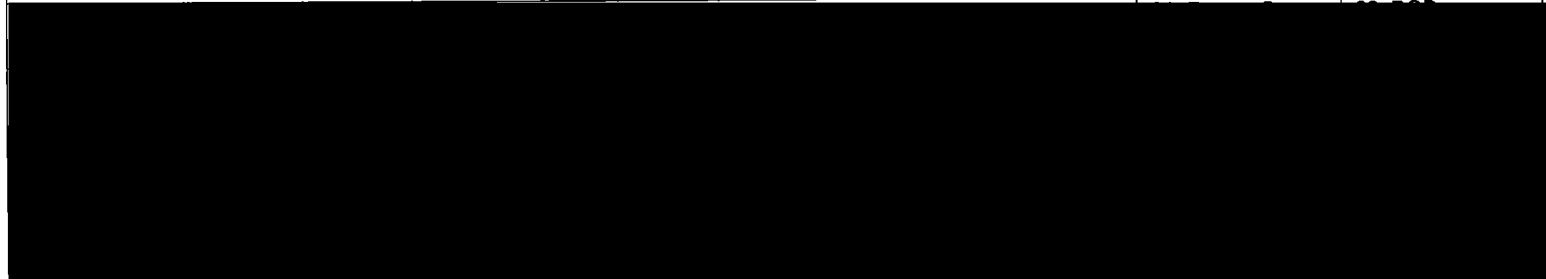

Narrative:

On 02-23-2017, 1700 hours, Detective Tillett, Detective Medici, Detective Rick Cobb and I met to the front of 4041 MacArthur Road for the purpose of conducting an additional neighborhood canvass for possible witnesses to the officer involved shooting (OIS) investigation. I started my portion of the canvass by attempting to contact residents on Hawthorne Street which was determined to be the likely path the suspect took from the original OIS scene to the residence on Sage Street.

I attempted to contact the residents at [REDACTED] and received no answer at the front door.

I then contacted [REDACTED] at her residence located at [REDACTED]. The interview with [REDACTED] was audio recorded. The following is a summary of that interview;

[REDACTED] said she was asleep with her husband [REDACTED] at the time of the shooting. [REDACTED] bedroom is located in the north-east portion of their residence which is closer to the [REDACTED] residence. [REDACTED] said she heard a "bunch of shots in a row" that woke her up. [REDACTED] estimated that she heard approximately eight to nine shots. [REDACTED] was awake and originally thought the sounds were fireworks but quickly figured out they were gunshots due to the distinctive sound they made. [REDACTED] originally thought the gunshots were coming from the direction of Sage Street. [REDACTED] did not see anyone outside her house until later on in the morning when she noticed all of the police activity.

During my interview with [REDACTED] arrived home from work. I then interviewed [REDACTED] which was also audio recorded. The following is a summary of my interview with [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] said he was lying in bed with his wife [REDACTED] just prior to hearing the gunshots. [REDACTED] said he was awake but just at that point of rest where he was about to fall asleep. [REDACTED] said he first heard two to three distinct loud bangs which he originally thought may have been fireworks due to people in his neighborhood often setting off fireworks. After the first two to three shots, [REDACTED] described a short pause and then heard a second volley of gunshots. [REDACTED] said the second volley of gunshots sounded as if there were two people firing these shots because of the over lapping quick succession. [REDACTED] believed he heard around 15 gunshots during the second volley of gunshots. [REDACTED] did not hear any additional gunshots after the second volley of shots.

After hearing the gunshots, [REDACTED] looked out his east kitchen window which faces MacArthur and then looked out the south living room window which faces [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] did not see anyone outside and did not notice any police activity as he looked out the first kitchen window. When [REDACTED] looked out the south living room window he immediately noticed police vehicles everywhere that appeared to be searching for someone. [REDACTED] remained inside the residence until he left for work at about 0530 hours.

The interview with [REDACTED] concluded my portion of the neighborhood canvass.

The audio recording of the interview with [REDACTED] was downloaded into the PUMA database at the Magnolia Street Police Station.
