Narrative

I responded to this incident and was assigned to interview witnesses at the Magnolia Police Station. Det. Rick Cobb informed me that two persons who were located in the residence where S-Garcia was barricaded were transported to the station and he identified them as V1 [REDACTED] and V2 [REDACTED]. I interviewed both of them separately and recorded the interviews. The following is a summary of their statements.

V1 [REDACTED]

V1 [REDACTED] told me that he lives at [REDACTED] with his girlfriend, V2 [REDACTED]. The house is being rented by V2 [REDACTED] her sister [REDACTED] and her [REDACTED] father [REDACTED]. V1 [REDACTED] told me that they were outside burning some wood in their side yard at the residence when he heard what sounded like three separate volleys of gunfire in the area. V1 [REDACTED] estimated he heard around (18) gunshots in total. About seven or eight minutes later he was standing out in the front yard with V2 [REDACTED] when S-Garcia came walking up to them in the yard. S-Garcia was bleeding from his leg and was carrying a black semi-automatic pistol in his right hand.

V- [REDACTED] told me that he recognized S-Garcia and recalled seeing him in the area a few weeks prior to this, but claimed he didn't know his name. He said they met at a corner in the area and they talked for a few minutes. S-Garcia asked him to hang out with him and he refused, telling him he "didn't do that stuff anymore". He also said he thinks he used to buy weed from him in the past.

S-Garcia told V1 [REDACTED] that he needed help getting out of the area and asked V1 [REDACTED] for a ride. V1 [REDACTED] had his pickup truck in the driveway. V1 [REDACTED] told me that he didn't want to get involved so he told S-Garcia that the tags were expired and they would be stopped instantly by the police, so he refused to take S-Garcia. V1 [REDACTED] said there were no police officers visible in the area during this time but he knew that S-Garcia had done something.

V1 [REDACTED] said that S-Garcia then walked towards the house and went inside the front door. He walked directly to the bathroom and got into the shower with all of his clothes on. V1 [REDACTED] said that he followed S-Garcia into the house because there were other people in the house and he felt he needed to protect them. The rest of the residents in the house were inside their bedrooms. V1 [REDACTED] girlfriend was with them initially but she ended up going upstairs into an attic room where her father was.

V1 [REDACTED] said he kept talking to S-Garcia and tried to get him to leave. S-Garcia instead asked V1 [REDACTED] if he could use his phone to call someone to come and get him. V1 [REDACTED] gave him the phone (that he and his girlfriend share) and S-Garcia kept dialing a phone number, but apparently he was using the wrong area code because he couldn't get through. S-Garcia then gave the phone back to V1 [REDACTED] and had him dial the number, but still the area code was wrong, so they never got through. V1 [REDACTED] said that S-Garcia told him the number, which he wrote down, and said the guy he was trying to call was named "Stranger." V1 [REDACTED] said S-Garcia then asked him if he could call someone to come and get him. V1 [REDACTED] said he told S-Garcia that he had no one to call for him. V1 [REDACTED] said that S-Garcia ended up keeping his phone and as far as he knew he still had it.

V1 [REDACTED] said that during this whole time S1 Garcia was telling him that he "Wasn't going to go out this way", "I'm going for life" (prison) and for V1 [REDACTED] to tell his mother and sister he loved them. V1 [REDACTED] said he believed that S-Garcia wasn't planning on giving up peacefully.

V1 [REDACTED] said that S-Garcia was bleeding profusely from an injury to his right foot or lower leg. V1 said he was getting towels for S-Garcia in an attempt to stop the bleeding but they were just soaking right through. S-Garcia was wearing a jacket which he took off and tried use on his foot to try and stop from bleeding all over the floors in the house. V1 [REDACTED] said that S-Garcia never told him what happened and he didn't ask.

V1 [REDACTED] said that S-Garcia never actually pointed the gun at him or told them he could not leave. V1 [REDACTED] said he didn't try to get out of the house because he felt like he had to stay and keep S-Garcia occupied because of all of the other people that were in the home. V1 [REDACTED] told me that he would not press charges against S-Garcia for kidnapping or false imprisonment because he has been in custody before, and if he ever went back inside he would have problems with the other inmates.

V1 [REDACTED] said that after what seemed like twenty minutes of S-Garcia being inside the house V2 [REDACTED] came out of one of the bedrooms and told them that the police were outside and she and her kids were ordered to come out of the house. S-Garcia asked them to stay inside but [REDACTED] refused and went out with her three kids. V1 [REDACTED] said that now the only people left in the house were himself, his girlfriend, her dad and a guy named [REDACTED] and his girlfriend [REDACTED].

V1 [REDACTED] said the rest of them were getting ready to go out the front door and he noticed S-Garcia was walking behind them. V1 [REDACTED] said he believed that S-Garcia may be planning on using them as shields between himself and the police and he was afraid of getting shot so he decided they should stay inside. S-Garcia then went out the back door for a second but came right back inside. While he was outside they all went into the attached garage. V1 [REDACTED] said S-Garcia was walking back and forth between the garage and the house and seemed to be getting desperate. After a few minutes [REDACTED] received a phone call from [REDACTED] (at the direction of the police) who requested that they open the garage door and come out. They complied and were detained by police. S-Garcia stayed in the house.

V1 [REDACTED] said S-Garcia had the gun in his right hand the whole time and never put it down.

V1 [REDACTED] told me that the police officers on scene accused him of hosing down the suspect's blood outside of his house. He denied it and said that they had hosed the area down before S-Garcia ever came up to them because they drug a trash can across that area and it left some sludge on the ground. I later interviewed V1 [REDACTED] girlfriend, V2 [REDACTED] and she told me she *did* attempt to wash away the suspect's blood outside the house, but only because the suspect ordered her to do it.

Since I believed that V1 [REDACTED] was familiar with S-Garcia I showed him a recent photo of him. V1 [REDACTED] said he believed that S-Garcia was the suspect we had been discussing.

V2 [REDACTED]

I asked V2 [REDACTED] to tell me who was at the house when the incident occurred. She said it was her dad [REDACTED] her sister [REDACTED] three children, her boyfriend V1 [REDACTED] and another couple named [REDACTED] and his girlfriend [REDACTED].

V2 [REDACTED] told me that she was on the side of her house on [REDACTED] this evening burning some wood on a bonfire with her boyfriend V1 [REDACTED] and her sister [REDACTED]. She was dousing the wood with gasoline to get it burning. She heard gunshots in the area and they talked about how it sounded like gunshots and not fireworks. Minutes later S-Garcia came up to them and said he needed help. He had a pistol in his right hand. V1 [REDACTED] was parked in the driveway and the door was open and S-Garcia got into the passenger seat. He asked V1 [REDACTED] to give him a ride out of the area so V1 [REDACTED] got into the driver's seat and the truck started backing out of the driveway. The truck then pulled back in and V1 [REDACTED] and S-Garcia got out. V1 [REDACTED] had apparently decided not to take S-Garcia anywhere in his truck.

V2 [REDACTED] said that S-Garcia was bleeding from his right leg and he had left a blood trail outside on the sidewalk and the driveway to the house. V2 [REDACTED] claimed that S-Garcia *told* her to clean up this trail and she complied because she was scared and he had a gun. V2 [REDACTED] said she used gasoline from the can she had for the fire and a broom and cleaned up the blood she saw. She told me that she knew a neighbor had seen her doing this but re-iterated she only did it because she was scared.

When V2 [REDACTED] was done she went into the house and S-Garcia and V1 [REDACTED] were sitting on the couch. S-Garcia told her to tie a tourniquet on his leg so she grabbed a pink towel and tried to tie it on his right leg tight enough to stop the bleeding. She said that she could not get it tight enough and S-Garcia was getting mad at her.

V2 [REDACTED] said that at some point somebody turned off all of the lights in the house and S-Garcia kept telling them to "be quiet." V2 [REDACTED] said that she actually fell asleep while sitting on the couch with them. Eventually her sister [REDACTED] came out of her room and told them that the police were outside and they ordered them to come out of the house. S-Garcia became desperate and ran out the back door of the house, but then quickly came back in.

[REDACTED] and her three kids [REDACTED] exited the house as instructed. The rest of them stayed inside and decided to go out into the garage. S-Garcia then ran back and forth between the garage door and the rest of the house but he never came into the garage with them. After a few minutes [REDACTED] received a phone call from [REDACTED] and she told him that the police wanted them to come outside. They opened the garage door and complied but S-Garcia stayed in the house.

V2 [REDACTED] said that at some point S-Garcia told them that he was "going to do life." She said he sounded desperate and as much as she hated saying it she hoped he committed suicide so no one else would get hurt. V2 [REDACTED] said that she did not know S-Garcia and she had never seen him before. While they were together with S-Garcia in the house V1 [REDACTED] did not act like he knew him either.

While I was speaking with V2 [REDACTED] Det. Simons gave me a picture of S-Garcia to show her. I told Det. Simons that I needed a six-pack line-up since she had never seen him before and I put

the photo face down on the table. V2 [REDACTED] spontaneously said "That's him". I asked her if she had seen the picture and she said she did. I then turned the picture over and showed it to her and she immediately said she was positive he was the subject we had been talking about.

I asked V2 [REDACTED] if she wanted to press charges against S-Garcia for holding her against her will with a gun. She told me she didn't know, and then she would press charges if her sister [REDACTED] did.

V1 [REDACTED] and V2 [REDACTED] were then released from the station and Officer Runstuck gave them a ride wherever they wanted to go.
