6 **EVIDENCE:**

7 The evidence was collected by Evidence Tech. Lane (see her supplemental report for  
8 complete details on all the evidence collected and photographs taken during the processing of the  
9 crime scene).

10  
11 **BACKGROUND & SOURCE:**

12 On 02-21-17 at approximately 1250 hours, I was assigned to assist with the processing of the  
13 second crime scene located at [REDACTED] in the City and County of Riverside. This was the  
14 location where the suspect, later identified as Marcelino Garcia, had barricaded himself after the  
15 Officer Involved Shooting (OIS) that occurred the previous night near 4041 MacArthur Rd. (see  
16 initial and supplemental reports for complete details). The [REDACTED] residence caught on fire  
17 and Garcia was subsequently located deceased in the bathtub in the northwest bathroom (see  
18 Riverside Police Department's Arson Investigation Report as to the cause of the fire, and the  
19 Riverside County Sheriff's Department Coroner's Report and Autopsy Protocol as to the cause of  
20 death).

21  
22 After the fire was extinguished and the residence was deemed safe enough to enter by the  
23 Riverside Fire Department, Detective Simons, Detective Cobb, and I searched for evidence.  
24 Evidence Tech. Lane assisted with processing the scene (photos and evidence collection).

27 **Scene Description**

28 [REDACTED] was a single story residence located to the north of the cul-de-sac of [REDACTED]  
29 [REDACTED] east of MacArthur Rd. The residence sustained significant damage as a result of the fire. See

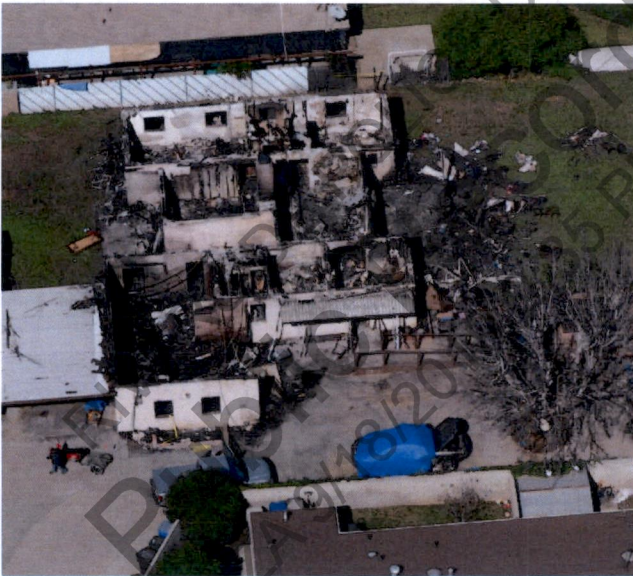

**Scene Processing / Evidence Collected**

Between 1250-1715 hours, Detective Simons, Detective Cobb, Evidence Tech. Lane, and I processed the scene which included locating, documenting, photographing, and collecting evidence. Evidence Tech. Lane started by taking photos of the miscellaneous SWAT non-lethal munitions paraphernalia located in and around the perimeter of the residence. The items were collected as evidence (SL01). Riverside Fire Department (RFD) personnel assisted us by

1 providing shovels and rakes to sift through the debris. RFD ran an "accelerant" dog through the  
2 location at approximately 1440 hours as part of their investigation into the fire.

3  
4 At 1503 hours, Detective Simons, Detective Cobb, and Evidence Tech. Lane entered the  
5 residence. Garcia was lying on his back in the bathtub in the northwest bathroom. His body was  
6 completely inside the bathtub with his head towards the faucet. Detective Simons noted that the  
7 faucet handle was in the on position towards the "warm" water side (see photos). There was  
8 debris on top of him almost covering him completely. The Riverside County Sheriff's Department  
9 Deputy Coroner was notified to respond to the location. Detective Simons carefully removed some  
10 of the debris from on top of Garcia's body and located a semi-automatic Smith & Wesson handgun  
11 in the bathtub between Garcia's leg. Evidence Tech. Lane collected the handgun (SL02).

12  
13 Underneath the handgun was a live 9mm round with a brass casing on the bottom of the  
14 bathtub between Garcia's legs. The live round was also collected (SL03). As RFD personnel were  
15 clearing debris from the northeast enclosed patio/room, they located an unloaded Remington 12ga  
16 shotgun. Evidence Tech. Lane photographed and collected the shotgun (SL04).

17  
18 Detective Simons sifted through the debris in the rest of the bathroom, around the bathtub  
19 where Garcia was found, and did not locate any additional evidence. Riverside County Sheriff's  
20 Department Deputy Coroner Maccie arrived at the location to conduct her investigation and  
21 recover Garcia's body. When Garcia's body was removed from the bathtub, Detective Simons  
22 located a 9mm brass casing on the bottom of the bathtub underneath where Garcia was lying.  
23 Evidence Tech. Lane photographed and collected the casing (SL05). After Garcia and the listed  
24 evidence were removed from the location, RFD took over to conduct their arson investigation. We  
25 cleared from the scene at 1715 hours.
