On the above date and time, partner Police Pilot M. Dillon (#1449) and I were on-duty at the police hangar, as the duty crew for the police helicopter. We were dispatched to assist RSO units who were in pursuit of a suspect on the N/B 215 FWY at Nuevo Road. Dispatch advised the suspect was armed with a firearm and was firing rounds at the pursuing units.

**Details:**

As we departed the airport, I was monitoring the RSO-Perris radio channel when I heard the pursuing units broadcast that the suspect was exiting the N/B 215 FWY, onto W/B Van Buren and that the suspect had fired more rounds at the pursuing units on Van Buren.

I immediately broadcast that information on RPD Channel 1. I continued to update our units of the location of the pursuit as we were flying towards it. At 1954 hours, we joined the pursuit as it continued W/B Van Buren at Washington.

As we joined the pursuit, I activated the DVR on our Churchill Augmented Reality Mapping System (ARS) and acquired the suspect vehicle on our FLIR 380HDC camera system.

I began broadcasting the pursuit on the RSO-Perris channel, while also updating RPD units on our channel. As the pursuit approached Mockingbird Canyon, RSO Supervision requested RPD units to take primary in the pursuit. I relayed that information to our units and began broadcasting the pursuit on RPD Channel 1.

Utilizing the ARS and video system, I continued to broadcast the streets, direction of travel and speeds of the suspect vehicle as he drove in excess of 70 to 100 miles per hour, on surface streets in the City of Riverside. The suspect had no regard for public safety, as he ran numerous stop signs, red traffic signals and several times drove on the wrong side of the road, causing oncoming traffic to have to take evasive actions to avoid collisions.

As the suspect drove W/B in the E/B lanes of Arlington, approaching California, he came upon opposite direction traffic and appeared as if he was going to ram vehicles to get through the traffic. As the other vehicles attempted to get out of the way, the suspect vehicle collided with a black SUV and came to a stop. I then heard units advise that an officer involved shoot had occurred and I noticed the suspect was slumped to his right side, inside the vehicle. I then assisted with setting containment of the scene with additional units.

Utilizing the infrared camera, I was able to maintain a visual of the suspect, through the open passenger side window and did not see any movement from the suspect for the remainder of the incident. We remained overhead until the tactical operation was complete and the suspect was secured. We cleared the scene at 2100 hours, at which time I deactivated the DVR.

After landing, I retrieved the thumb drive from the Churchill System. I took the thumb drive to the Magnolia Street Station, where I transferred both the raw camera videos and the map overlay videos to Detective Beler's computer. **NFI**
