62. Narrative of Supplemental Report

62a. Audio Recording Available?

On August 2, 2018, Detective K. Beler requested and obtained a Search Warrant for the harvesting of any collision related data from the Event Data Recorder within the suspect's vehicle.

On August 7, 2018, Detectives Jones, Fishell, Soria and I went to the Magnolia Ave Police Station. The vehicle was being stored in the vehicle evidence bay adjacent to the Crime Scene Technician office. Senior Evidence Technician J. Greer escorted us in to the evidence bay. The vehicle described in the Search Warrant is a "2012 Chrysler Sebring, silver with a black top," California license plate 7JPW282. I compared the Vehicle Identification Number (VIN) to that listed in the Search Warrant; the two compared.

The 2012 Chrysler Sebring is equipped with an internal Airbag Control Module (ACM). The ACM monitors various systems within the vehicle including speed, acceleration, brake system status, seat belt status, and c. In the event the vehicle experiences a change of velocity (Delta V) approximately 5 mph or greater within a 150 ms period, the ACM may activate and record both pre and post triggering event data.

Detective Jones donned a full body PPE suit and gloved before entering the vehicle. He located and attached the Collision Data Retrieval tool cable to the vehicle's internal On-Board Diagnostic II port located under the

driver's side dashboard knee-bolster. I initialized the device and began to image the vehicle's ACM. The CDR software indicated a complete image was downloaded to the computer.

I copied the data file from the computer onto a DVD. I booked the DVD into Evidence at the Lincoln Avenue police station.

ANALYSIS:

I used Bosch's Crash Data Retrieval software, version 17.8 to view the ACM data image. The ACM's internal record of the Vehicle Identification Number was the same as on the vehicle and as on the Search Warrant. There were no recorded events stored within the ACM.
