On 07/20/2018, at approximately 2030 hours, I received a callout request from SGT CRAWFORD to respond to the scene of Arlington Avenue and Streeter Avenue to assist with an Attempt Homicide (OIS) Investigation.

At approximately 2229 hours, I arrived on scene, making contact with SR. FORENSIC SPECIALIST S. MCKAY-DAVIS and DETECTIVE K. CORBETT, who request that I take photographs in order to locate vehicles prior to moving them.

PHOTOGRAPHS TAKEN:

At the request of SFS MCKAY-DAVIS, I took photographs locating a silver Hyundai Odyssey van, CA 5WAP159, on Arlington Avenue (east-bound), just east of Streeter Avenue.

I was then re-directed by DETECTIVE CORBETT to photograph and locate an unmarked Hemet Police Unit. I took overall photographs locating a black colored Ford, Crown Victoria, CA EXEMPT plate 1264350, on Arlington Avenue (west-bound), just east of Streeter Avenue. I also took overall exterior photographs of this unmarked unit.

I finished my assignment and left the location at approximately 2330 hours. These (34) digital images were uploaded into the Forensic Unit, Digital Information Management System (DIMS station).

CHANGE LOCATION:

At approximately 2345 hours, while in the Forensic Unit of the Magnolia Station, I was requested by DETECTIVE R. COBB to photograph and chart a number of Riverside Police Department officers.

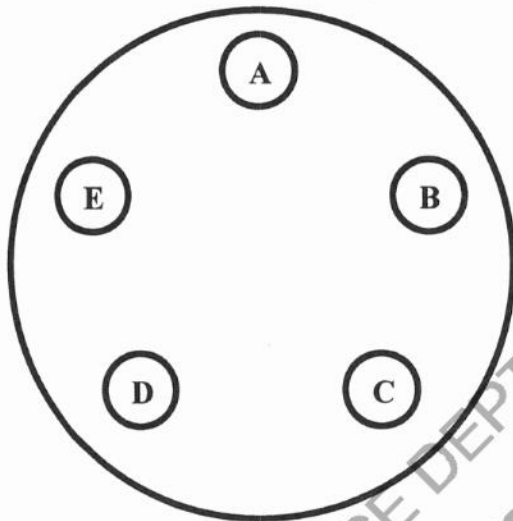
