8 On 07-20-18, at 1947 hours, while on uniformed patrol in a black and white police vehicle, in the City and
9 County of Riverside, partner Officer Newton and I heard dispatch broadcast a pursuit involving Riverside
10 Sheriff Department deputies who were being fired at by a suspect from the vehicle.

11
12 **Narrative:**

13 The vehicle was described as 2012 Chrysler, grey in color with a CA license plate of 7JPW282. As we
14 monitored the pursuit, we learned the suspect vehicle entered the City of Riverside by exiting the northbound
15 215 Freeway at Van Buren Blvd and was driving westbound. The directions where the suspect was traveling
16 were being broadcasted over the radio. Officer Newton and I made our way to the area of the pursuit and
17 attempted to locate a safe location to assist with the incident. Due to the amount of police vehicles in the
18 area, Officer Newton and I drove northbound on Monroe Street until we reached Arlington Avenue. We
19 began driving eastbound on Arlington Avenue and as we approached California Avenue, it was broadcasted
20 that the suspect vehicle was traveling westbound in the eastbound lanes. Officer Newton pulled our unit over
21 to avoid driving head on into the suspect. As I exited our unit, I heard 2-3 gunshots and moved out of the line
22 of fire. I immediately assisted with clearing the parking lot of Sears [REDACTED] of pedestrians
23 and vehicles.

24
25 I was then directed to the parking lot south of Arlington Avenue to interview several subjects who were
26 involved in the incident.

27
28 I spoke to W/ [REDACTED] who gave me the following statement in summary:

29
30 W/ [REDACTED] was facing east on Arlington Avenue at California Avenue behind a silver Nissan sedan.
31 The light was green and as he proceeded straight he saw the "suspect" driving westbound in the eastbound
32 lanes of traffic, driving toward him. He saw the male (who he believed was the one being chased by police)
33 and described him as a "bald" male; he was not sure if he was Hispanic or not. He saw a police vehicle drive
34 onto Arlington Avenue from California Avenue, and the officer who was in that police vehicle started
35 shooting at the "suspect." W/ [REDACTED] stated he exited his vehicle out of his passenger side and heard another
36 gun shot. In total, he described hearing three gun shots. He noticed the "suspect" vehicle "tapped" his vehicle
37 as he was running away from it. W/ [REDACTED] believe the incident occurred at approximately 2008 hours.

38
39 I spoke to W/ [REDACTED] who gave me the following statement in summary:

40
41 W/ [REDACTED] was on Arlington Avenue facing eastbound and was three cars behind a red light.
42 He saw approximately 30 police vehicles approaching the intersection driving westbound. He then sees 3-5
43 police vehicles driving onto Arlington Avenue from California Avenue. The vehicle in front of him
44 suddenly stopped their vehicle causing him to "barely tapped" the vehicle. He began to pull over because of
45 the collision but he noticed "the suspect" driving on the wrong side of the rode. He saw an officer draw his
46 weapon and the officer fired (approximately 5) gunshots. He believes one shot was from a handgun and the

47 other 4 were from “an AR” possibly “55.6mm.” The officer was facing westbound when the shots were fired
48 according to W/ [REDACTED]

49
50 I spoke to W/ [REDACTED] who gave me the following statement in summary:

51
52 W/ [REDACTED] stated she “did not see anything” because a male in a black trailblazer in front of her
53 exited his vehicle and ran away, so she did the same. At that time, she heard 2 gunshots as she was running
54 away from the vehicle.

55
56 I spoke to W/ [REDACTED] who gave me the following statement in summary:

57
58 W/ [REDACTED] stated he was passing the light on Arlington Avenue driving westbound toward Madison
59 Avenue when he saw several police vehicles. He believed there was a checkpoint, until he saw several
60 subjects exit their vehicles and run away. At that time, he heard 3 gunshots.

62 After obtaining the listed statements, I was relieved by Sergeant Munoz .
