## **Narrative**

On 07-26-18 Det. Beler asked me to assist her in this case by searching the listed involved vehicles, which were secured at the Magnolia Street Police Facility. Det. Beler informed me that both vehicles had been photographed at the scene of the incident by Forensic Specialist (FS) McKay-Davis on 07-20-18. Det. Beler also provided me with a copy of the search warrant that she had obtained for the suspect vehicle which had been signed by the Honorable Judge Larrie Brainard of the Riverside Superior Court on 07-25-18.

Det. Beler told me that on 07-20-18 the suspect vehicle being driven by S-Levario attempted to evade uniformed police officers investigating a shooting in the City of Hemet. During the ensuing chase S-Levario fired a semi-automatic handgun at pursuing officers. The pursuit ended in the area of Arlington Ave and Streeter in the City of Riverside where an Officer Involved Shooting occurred, involving S-Levario and Riverside Police Officer J. O'Farrell.

### Unit #3135

I spoke to FS McKay-Davis. She told me that she had already photographed Officer O'Farrell's police unit #3135 at the scene and the interior just needed to be searched. I located the unit secured and locked in the Magnolia Street Station lot and saw that it had what appeared to be a single outgoing gunshot to the front windshield. I then searched the vehicle and did not locate anything of evidentiary value. After I completed my search FS McKay-Davis photographed the interior driver's area.

FS Meyer and I then processed the 2012 Chrysler Sebring. Before any search FS Meyer photographed the entire vehicle. She also collected DNA swabs from the steering wheel should they be needed. The interior and exterior was also searched for fingerprints. See her report for results.

# **Chrysler Sebring**

Traffic Collision (T/C) Damage

I noted possible (T/C) damage to the following areas of the vehicle:

- Minor T/C damage to the driver's side front fender with possible black paint transfer on the quarter panel and possible white paint transfer on the headlight glass
- Minor damage to bottom and middle of the front spoiler
- Minor damage to the front bumper near the license plate
- Black paint transfer on the pass side front wheel/rim and side-view mirror
- Very minor wide scrape down passenger side front fender area

### Windows

- Both front windows were down. I later rolled them up and noted they were intact and undamaged. It should be noted that when I obtained the ignition keys from FS McKay-Davis and put them in the ignition to see if the front windows were intact the stereo came on and the volume was extremely loud
- Both rear windows were completely gone (shattered) and the back seat area and floorboard were full of glass

# Possible Bullet strikes

- I noted a possible projectile strike to the lower front windshield area next to the driver's side "A" pillar. The projectile did not penetrate the windshield. It's unknown if this was caused by an incoming or outgoing projectile
- I noted a possible graze on the outside of the convertible roof, above the driver's seat area, which tore the roof fabric. There was no corresponding dent in the frame underneath the tear
- I noted (3) penetrating strikes to the front windshield in front of the passenger seat area. These strikes appeared to project outward, from the interior out. Two of them were right next to each other near the middle of the windshield. The third strike was smaller, and was located lower and nearer to the passenger side "A" pillar. This third strike occurred after the first two listed here based on the intersecting fractures and may have been caused by a fragment
- The driver's side rear side window was shattered, but debris on the top of the interior panel the window rolls down into, along with corresponding fragment holes in the driver's side headrest, and damage to the front passenger interior door panel, suggest a projectile likely penetrated the driver's side rear window and fragmented. These fragments traveled through the driver's side headrest and struck the interior of the passenger door

Evidence collected from the Interior of the Vehicle

- I located an expended .40 caliber casing head stamped "SW .40 Win" on the rear passenger floorboard
- I located an expended .40 caliber casing head stamped "SW .40 Win" under the spare tire in the trunk
- I located a plastic, round less-lethal wadding part on the driver's side floorboard
- I located a round less lethal paper wadding part on the front passenger seat.
- I located a yellow less lethal bean bag on the passenger side floorboard
- The center console area and cup holder were covered in what appeared to be blood. A swab was taken

All of the listed evidence was photographed and collected by FS Meyer and later booked into evidence.
