1 **Details:**
2

3 On Thursday, 03-08-18, about 1735 hours, I was on patrol en route to the city of Eastvale
4 when dispatch advised there were shots fired at 9931 Willowbrook Rd in the city of Jurupa
5 Valley. Riverside Police Department (RPD) officers were at the location doing surveillance and
6 requested assistance. I responded from Cantu-Galleano Rd x I-15 and arrived about 1741 hours.
7

8 As I arrived, RPD officers were bringing people out of the house. Deputy Sanderson
9 waited with a woman and her six children. Other officers brought out a male and a female who
10 were handcuffed. I waited with those two to free up the RPD officers. The male was believed to
11 be the father of the children, and the handcuffed female wearing all black claimed to be the aunt
12 of him and woman. Eventually, RPD officers took the female to a patrol car elsewhere and the
13 male was placed in a patrol car next to the woman and children. Deputy Sanderson was told to
14 watch the male, and I then assisted him in watching the woman and kids.

16 About 1910 hours, we were preparing the family to be transported to the Jurupa Valley
17 Station. Due to the young age of the children, we needed to get supplies from the house. I
18 coordinated with Deputy Balderrama inside the house. I entered the house through the front door
19 and retrieved a diaper bag from the master bedroom, diapers from the master closet, a baby bottle
20 from the living room couch, a baby bottle from the kitchen table, 5 water bottles from a case of
21 water on the kitchen table, and baby formula from the kitchen counter. I took the items outside
22 to the mother. I then re-entered the house to fill one of the bottles with milk from the refrigerator
23 and I grabbed a blanket out of the crib. About 10 minutes after getting the items, the mother and
24 six children were transported to the Jurupa Valley Station.

26 About 1940 hours, I cleared the scene and signed out of the critical incident log on the
27 east perimeter which was being maintained by a RPD officer. This concluded my activity at the
28 scene.
