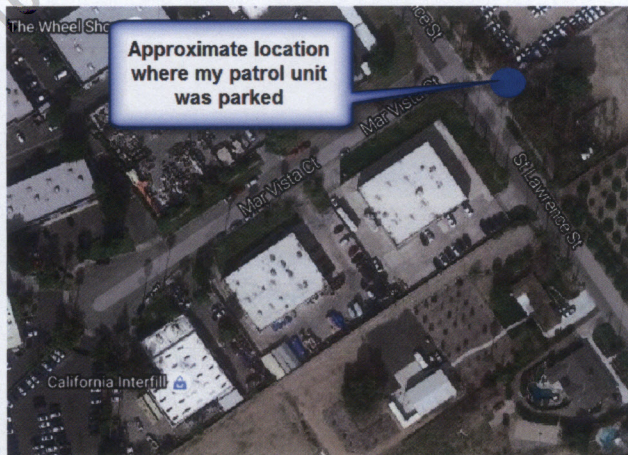

12 On Sunday, 10/31/16, at approximately 2345 hours, partner Officer Cuevas and I were parked in our patrol  
13 unit, in an alcove on St. Lawrence.

15 I was driving the patrol unit and Officer Cuevas was sitting in the front passenger seat. The reason I parked  
16 my patrol in that location was to begin typing a police report from earlier in the day. At around 2350 hours, I  
17 noticed a vehicle approaching from the west on Mar Vista Ct., towards my patrol unit. The vehicle pulled  
18 alongside of my patrol car with the driver side window rolled down.

2 The vehicle was occupied by one white male adult (RP1), who was sitting in the driver front seat. RP1 told me  
3 the following:

4 He said there is a male subject stealing pallets from one of the businesses on the south side of Mar  
5 Vista Ct.

6 I told RP1 that I would look into the matter and speak with the individual stealing the pallets. RP1 thanked me  
7 and left the area.

8 I drove west on Mar Vista Ct. and began checking the businesses located on the south side of the street with  
9 my patrol units spotlight. When I drove upon the far west end of the second business (Arc of Riverside  
10 County), I noticed a white single cab truck (suspect vehicle) backed up next to west property wall of the  
11 business. The truck had several wooden pallets stacked on it.

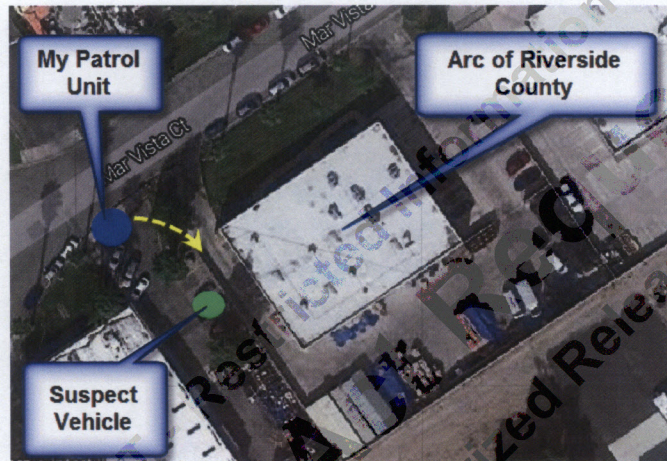

13 I did not see anyone in the area near the truck, so I walked towards the exit/entry gate of the business to see  
14 if anyone was in the rear portion.

2 At around the same time that I arrived at the gate, I heard Officer Cuevas yell towards the direction of the  
3 suspect vehicle. I then heard someone yell back from the direction of the suspect vehicle saying, "Okay,  
4 Okay." I looked towards the suspect vehicle and noticed S/Hayes walking east from his truck towards the  
5 west property wall of Arc. He did not comply with Officer Cuevas' commands and instead jumped over the  
6 block wall, into the rear portion of Arc. I looked through the exit/entry gate to see S/Hayes, but I was unable  
7 to locate him. I then ran east across the front yard portion of Arc to make sure that S/Hayes hadn't tried to  
8 flee the area by jumping over the second exit/entry gate located on the east side of the building.



9

10 I stopped for a moment once I reached the east side of the business to see if I could locate S/Hayes on the rear  
11 portion of the property, but I did not. I then jumped over the exit/entry gate of a separate business next  
12 door, located to the east at 2802 Saint Lawrence St. because the elevation of the property was higher than  
13 Arc's, which allowed me to gain a better position, oversight of Arc's rear yard, and possibly locate S/Hayes. I  
14 went to the far south east corner of Arc's property wall and looked for S/Hayes down below.

2 After about 1 minute of looking into Arc's rear yard, I noticed S/Hayes trying to hide down below amongst  
3 some of the proeprty being stored. I shouted for him to put up his hands and come out, but he immediately  
4 ran away from me back towards the location of his vehicle.

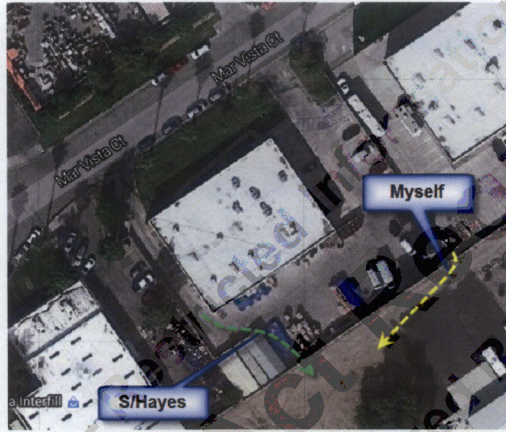

6 I then heard Officer Cuevas yell, "Let me see your hands." Seconds after, I watched S/Hayes run toward the  
7 south property line wall of Arc and ultimately jump over. Due to the hieght of the south wall, S/Hayes first  
8 had to climb onto a large bin before jumping the block wall. Once he was over the wall, I decided to jump the  
9 same wall and follow after him.

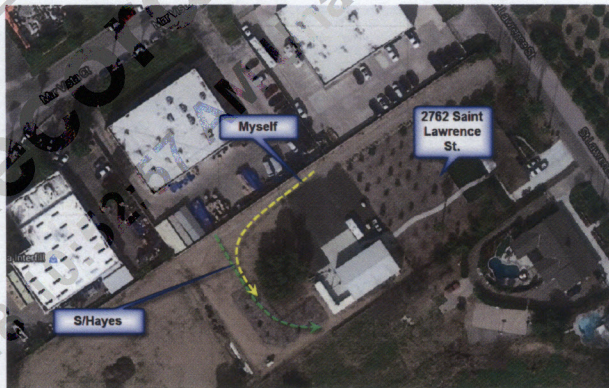

2 S/Hayes continued to run south through a property located at 2762 Saint Lawrence St. and I continued to  
3 follow him. I did not lose sight of S/Hayes as I followed.

5 As I followed S/Hayes through the property I began yelling for him to get on the ground as I pointed my gun  
6 at him. He was no longer running from me and was moving at a pace just faster than a regular walk. I  
7 continued to tell him to stop and get on the ground. For a brief period, S/Hayes stopped and got down to his  
8 knees. It appeared as though he was going to comply with my commands, but I was still about 30 yards away  
9 from him. I continued towards him and told him to lay out flat. I immediately noticed that he was looking  
10 around at his surroundings as though he was planning to run from me. Once I was about 15 yards from him,  
11 he did just that, and fled east. He still was not moving very fast and it appeared as though he was out of  
12 breath.



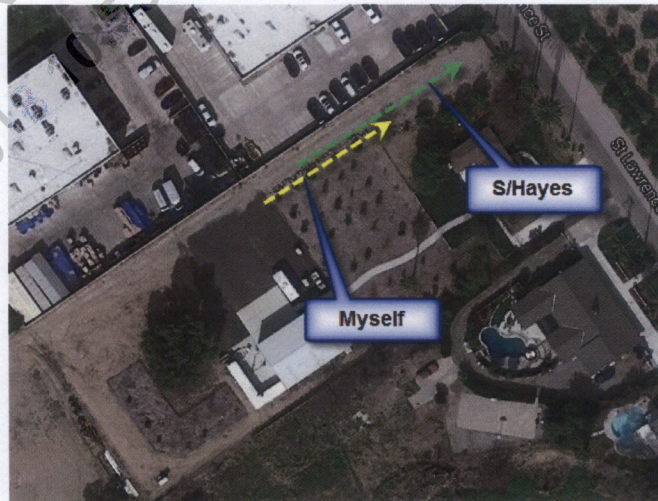

2 I continued to follow S/Hayes, but maintained my distance from him since I was unsure if he had any  
3 weapons on his person. S/Hayes was now walking towards Saint Lawrence St and he appeared to be out of  
4 breath/ fatigued. I yelled for him to stop and get on the ground, but he told me no and kept walking towards  
5 Saint Lawrence.

7 S/Hayes approached a property line fence located to the east, which was about a 6 feet tall chain link fence.  
8 He jumped over the fence and crossed east over Saint Lawrence St. I jumped the fence as well and continued

2 Once S/Hayes crossed over Saint Lawrence St. he went straight into the orange groves, however, just passed  
3 the first row of orange trees was a chain link perimeter fence, which kept him from continuing further into  
4 the groves. S/Hayes turned south at the fence line and continued walking at a brisk pace. He walked about 15  
5 feet south along the fence line, parallel with Saint Lawrence St. when another officer (Sgt. McCoy) arrived on-  
6 scene. I watched as S/Hayes slowly laid down onto his stomach and place his hands behind his back. I advised  
7 Sgt. McCoy that I would place the handcuffs on S/Hayes.

8 S/Hayes was laying face down on his stomach on the east side of Saint Lawrence St. He was lying with his  
9 head to the southwest and his feet pointing northeast. I noticed that S/Hayes was wearing a pair of black  
10 gloves, which appeared to be made of a latex material. I approached S/Hayes from the north and  
11 immediately grabbed control of S/Hayes two gloved hands with my left hand placed in the center of his lower  
12 back. I positioned my body weight onto S/Hayes left hip as I maintained control of his hands. S/Hayes seemed  
13 to be co-operating, so I attempted to place handcuffs on his wrist with my right hand. As soon as I was about  
14 to place on the handcuffs, S/Hayes began yelling, "I cant breathe." I told S/Hayes that I simply needed to  
15 place the handcuffs on his wrist and I would be able to let go of him. He tensed his arms and it felt as though  
16 he was trying to pull his hands away from me. I had to grab ahold of his right wrist with my right hand as well  
17 as continued to grasp his left wrist with my left hand, in order to maintain control. I was still uncertain if  
18 S/Hayes had any type of weapons on his person and I did not want him reaching or obtaining any weapons  
19 that would put me and fellow officers in further danger.

20 While S/Hayes was pulling his hands away from me and attempting to roll over to his side, I noticed Sgt.  
21 McCoy take hold of S/Hayes right arm/wrist. I transitioned both my hands to S/Hayes left wrist and I was  
22 eventually able to place both S/Hayes wrists in cuffs. I rolled S/Hayes onto his left side and searched his  
23 person for any possible weapons. As I searched him, it appeared as though S/Hayes was unconcious, but he  
24 he had a pulse. Medical aid was immediately called to the scene and both RFD/ AMR arrived shortly after.

1 Once RFD arrived on-scene, I left S/Hayes to the care of fellow officers and RFD while I retraced both mine  
2 and S/Hayes steps to make sure there was no contraband left in the area. When I arrived back to the location  
3 of S/Hayes, I was notified that S/Hayes had gone into full cardiac arrest. AMR immediately transported  
4 S/Hayes to Parkview Hospital for medical aid and I road in the ambulance as well.

5 Once we arrived at the hospital, S/Hayes was taken inside and hospital staff began administering medical aid.  
6 His Time of Death was pronounced on 10/31/16, at 0054 hours. I was relieved from the hospital by Officer  
7 Macek and I returned to Lincoln Station. I later went back to the scene and met with Homicide Detectives to  
8 retrace the incident.

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
