4 **Details:**

5 On 10/31/16, 0007 hours, I was dispatched to assist other Officers who were in foot pursuit of a
6 suspect at the dead end of Mar Vista. When I arrived I located Sgt. McCoy and Officer Brandt in the
7 orange grove, just off the street, across from 2762 St. Lawrence.

8 They had already taken S/Hayes into custody and had placed hand cuffs on him. Officer Brandt
9 was holding S/Hayes on his left side. I took over holding S/Hayes on his left side so that Officer Brandt
10 could retrace his path and check for any items that may have been thrown.

11 While holding S/Hayes I check his pulse and felt a strong carotid pulse with my left index and
12 middle finger on the right side of his neck. When I placed my hand on his neck S/Hayes would also grunt
13 from my fingers on his neck. I could also see the rise and fall of his chest. I check his pulse at least three
14 times prior to RFD arriving on scene. The last time I check was less than minute prior to RFD arriving.

15 When RFD did arrive one of the paramedics also check his pulse and stated he could feel a pulse
16 but that it appeared that S/Hayes had stopped breathing. I removed S/Hayes' right hand-cuff and placed
17 both cuffs on his left hand to prevent him from using them as a weapon and to expedite RFD immediately
18 providing life saving measures to aid S/Hayes. A short time later AMR transported S/Hayes to Parkview
19 Hospital.

20 I held the scene until I was relieved by evidence technicians who collected the clothing that had
21 been left behind.
