Narrative:

On 10-31-16, at approximately 0120 hours, Sergeant T. Banks called me and asked that I respond to Saint Lawrence and Mar Vista, in the city and county of Riverside, regarding a death investigation. I arrived at the scene at approximately 0210 hours. Upon my arrival, I attended a briefing of incident provided by Sergeant W. McCoy. Following the briefing, I was assigned as the Case Agent and Detective M. Medici as the Co-Case Agent. Detective D. Smith and Senior Forensic Technician S. Lane processed the scene.

Officer B. Brandt (#1821) then walked us through the scene and showed us the path of travel of S/ Hayes and where he was ultimately taken into custody. At the completion of the walk through, I spoke with Sergeant W. McCoy and Officer Brandt about documenting the events. Sergeant W. McCoy and Officer Burton were comfortable with preparing their own police reports covering the incident. The decision was then made the officers who responded to the scene would also prepared their own police reports rather than being interviewed by detectives.

At approximately 0400 hours, Detective Medici and I responded to Parkview Community Hospital where Officer Macek was standing by with S/ Edward Thomas Hayes III (refer to Detective Medici's Supplemental Report). We were present as Riverside County Sheriff-Coroner Deputy Ferris processed Hayes' body before being transported to the Coroner's Office.

On 10-31-16, at approximately 1130 hours, I spoke with Hayes' father, Edward Hayes Jr, on the telephone. Mr. Hayes said his son had an addiction to heroin but stopped using about 8-9 years ago. Mr. Hayes is unaware of any other drug use except possibly marijuana. [REDACTED]

medical problems. Mr. Hayes said his son previously spent time in prison for burglary and recently moved to the Riverside area. He had no additional information.

AUTOPSY

I attended the autopsy of Edward Hayes at the Riverside County Sheriff/Coroner's Office in Perris CA on 10-31-16.

Dr. Hunt examined Hayes' body and noted only scattered, red abrasions on the left lower leg. She also noted an abnormal curvature with a "bulging" muscle in the bicep area of his upper left arm. Dissection revealed a previously ruptured bicep tendon, which is healed and fibrotic. At the time of autopsy the cause of death could not be determined and was pending toxicology results.

COBAN

I obtained COBAN video from marked Riverside Police Department units #3530, #3535, #3538, #3542, and #3545.

After reviewing the recordings, it was determined that units #3530 (Officer Chen; #1847), #3542 (Sergeant Lewis; #1023) and #3545 (Officer Hua; #1704 and Officer E. Vazquez; #1724) activated their emergency gear, initiating the COBAN recording, as they began responding to the call. However, none of these officers made it to the scene so COBAN did not capture any pertinent information.

I reviewed the COBAN video from Officer Brandt's and Officer Cuevas' assigned unit (#3538). This COBAN had two recordings downloaded. It captured a silver vehicle pulling up to the driver side of the unit. The video showed the unit drive down Mar Vista Court and the spotlight shined on a white truck with numerous pallets in the bed. The video showed the feet of a suspect under the truck and him going over the top of a wall. The video also showed assisting officers arriving to the location of the suspect vehicle and on two occasions the unit moves from the suspect vehicle to the location of Hayes on Saint Lawrence Street. There was no video of Hayes on Saint Lawrence Street. At the beginning of the video, an officer is heard yelling at Hayes to show his hands. There are several times when the audio loses connection (probably when Brandt is in foot pursuit and out of range). On one occasion when the unit is moved to Saint Lawrence Street you can hear Brandt explaining how they took Hayes into custody.

I reviewed the COBAN video from Officer Lopez' assigned unit (#3535). The video captured Sergeant McCoy's unit (#3131) stopped on Saint Lawrence Street and has audio of Officer Lopez explaining the condition of Hayes to medical personnel when they arrived. The video also captured Riverside Fire Department personnel leaving the scene.

The following timeline was established after reviewing Riverside Police Department and Riverside Fire Department CAD printouts and radio traffic and COBAN video from Officer Brandt and Officer Cuevas' marked unit (#3538).

TIMELINE

- 10/30/16 @ 2349 hours – Officers Brandt and Cuevas (C136) backed unit #3538 into a driveway on Saint Lawrence Street at Mar Vista Ct. (COBAN)
- 10/31/16 @ 0000 hours – Silver vehicle (Adamiccka) approached unit e/b Mar Vista Ct and pulls up to the driver side of unit. (COBAN)
- 0002 hours – Unit #3538 pulled up to ARC and shined the spotlight on a white truck with wood pallets stacked in the bed. The suspect's feet appeared under the driver side of truck. The suspect fled south bound where he jumped over the wall into the rear of ARC. Officer Cuevas shined his flash light on the suspect going over wall. (COBAN)
- 0007 hours – Officer Cuevas was at the driver side of his unit and shined his flashlight on the truck and then the wall. Officer Cuevas yelled commands for the suspect to show his hands. (COBAN)
- 0007:22 – Brandt/ Cuevas arrived on scene to the rear of CHP. They asked for additional units. (RPD CAD & radio)
- 0007:55 – S. Lopez (C323) arrived on scene. (RPD CAD)
- 0009:33 – Brandt said he is following the suspect who is not stopping, is walking towards Saint Lawrence and is not compliant. Dispatch went 10-33. (RPD CAD & radio)
- 0009:49 – Brandt described the suspect wearing blue jeans and black shirt. Brandt said he is getting ready to hop the fence on the Saint Lawrence side. (RPD CAD & radio)
- 0011:07 – Sergeant McCoy (S63) advised he is with Brandt and they are taking the suspect into custody. (RPD CAD and radio)
- 0012:29 – McCoy asked dispatch to start medical aid. (RPD CAD & radio)
- 0012:37 – Dispatch went 10-34. (RPD CAD)
- 0012:46 – RFD/ medical aid is dispatched. (RFD CAD)
- 0014:55 – RFD Engine 10 is en route. (RFD CAD)
- 0017:41 – RFD Engine 10 is on scene. (RFD CAD)
- 0022:28 – RFD Engine 10 advised the suspect is in full arrest. Dispatch advised AMR. (RFD CAD)
- 0034:00 – Officer Brandt and Engine 10 advised they are en route to Parkview Hospital with AMR. (RPD, RFD CAD and radio)
- 0040:01 – AMR arrived at Parkview Hospital (RPD CAD)
- 0054 hours – Suspect is pronounced deceased. (RPD reports)

The investigation is suspended pending Autopsy results / Coroner's Review.
