Notification and Investigation:

On October 31, 2016 at approximately 0120 hours, Sergeant Troy Banks requested my assistance reference a death investigation. I responded to the intersection of St Lawrence and Mar Vista in the city and county of Riverside. Detective Jim Brandt and Detective David Smith also responded to assist with the investigation. I arrived at approximately 0200 hours and assumed the role of Co Case Agent. Detective Brandt is the Case Agent and Detective Smith handled the crime scene investigation. Suspect Edward Hayes had already been transported to Parkview Hospital by American Medical Response (AMR) before detectives arrived on scene. Upon our arrival we were given a briefing of the incident by Patrol Sergeant William McCoy. After the briefing Detective Brandt and I responded to the Emergency Room at Parkview Hospital. Hayes was in room #2 of the Emergency Room. Riverside Police Patrol Officer Robert Macek stayed with Mr. Hayes since he arrived. Hayes was officially pronounced dead at 0054 hours by ER Trauma Assistant Amanda Waugh.

Evidence Technician Susan Lane responded to RCH to assist us by photographing Hayes and taking his clothing. She also took a pair of black gloves Hayes was wearing as evidence. At 0440 hours, Deputy Ferris (RSO Coroner's Office) assisted us by examining Hayes's body and processing both of his hands. She took photographs, fingerprints, and nail clippings while at the hospital. During her examination I noted Hayes had multiple tattoos (Wizards and dragons) on each of his arms. He also had a small swastika on his left ankle.

The only injuries I noted on Hayes' body were minor abrasions to his left shin and right wrist. According to Deputy Ferris these injuries appeared to be a day or two old based on the beginning stages of scabbing. The only other thing I noted was a large raised bump or possible abscess on the bicep of his left arm.

We cleared the hospital on October 31, 2016 at approximately 0500 hours. The Coroner's Office took custody of Hayes's body and transported him to the Riverside County Coroner's office.

Phone Interview with RP Robert Adamiczka: (Audio recorded)

Robert Adamiczka is employed at [REDACTED] in Riverside. His office is located in the same parking lot immediately west of 8138 Mar Vista where S/Hayes's truck was ultimately recovered.

Robert said at approximately 1930 hours, he was inside his office using the computer for several hours. His car, (Silver Nissan Versa) was parked in the parking lot. He wasn't aware that anything was even occurring outside until he left his office just before midnight. Robert walked to his car and saw an older white pickup truck backed into a parking space just 15 yards east of his car. He saw an unknown male standing near the truck by the wall of a neighboring business at 8178 Mar Vista. He saw a second unknown male in the rear yard of 8178 Mar Vista handing pallets over the wall to the other male loading them on the truck.

Robert said he may have made the comment, "Oh, so you're taking some pallets huh?" Even though he made the comment Robert said he intentionally tried not to draw attention to himself. He got into his car, backed out of the driveway, then he drove away eastbound on Mar Vista. When he got to the intersection of St. Lawrence and Mar Vista he saw a patrol car. Robert told two police officers that there were two men in the process of stealing pallets and loading them on a white pick-up truck at a business at the end of the street. The officers drove towards the location and Robert drove away.

Robert said he cannot identify either of the two suspects other than he knows that they were both males. He said it was dark and he intentionally didn't want to look at them so he didn't draw attention to himself.
