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Statements Cont'd:

"fuck you" to oncoming traffic. W1 did not provide her husband's personal information. According to W1, S1 was standing in the middle of the street as cars were swerving to avoid hitting him.

When the first police officers arrived on scene, S1 swung at the officers. When S1 swung at the officers, the officers and S1 began struggling. W1 described S1 as swinging at the officers with a fist. S1 said the police officers struck S1 with a baton and they went to the ground. While on the ground, S1 was still struggling with the officers, punching and kicking. W1 could not confirm how many times S1 punched and kicked the officers. W1 also stated that S1 was tasered by officers. W1 identified the taser by seeing it as well as hearing it. W1 continued to say AMR arrived and put S1 in the ambulance. Shortly after, several other police officers arrived.

Statement: W2's Statement

After interviewing W1/Sarah Rescorl, I interviewed the manager of the apartment complex at 7850 Cypress Ave., W2/Sidney Zamora. W2 witnessed the incident from the patio of apartment, which was approximately 150 yards away from the street. W2 said he heard S1 say something to the effect of, "fuck you, I can do what I want." S1 was also yelling at people and vehicles as they passed by.

W2 said when police officers arrived at the scene, they went to stop S1 and S1 punched one of the officers.

I asked W2 if there was any video surveillance of Cypress Ave. from his apartment complex and he said no. The only video W2 had available was that of the vehicle entry gate at the rear of the complex.

A=Sarah Rescorl

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Q: Okay, go ahead.

A: Okay, we were coming back from trick or treating the guy was saying things like right here in front of this house.

Q: Uh-huh.

A: And what - and, um, he's throwing stuff right in the middle of the street, yelling. Cars were stopping for him. Some cars were going by so fast.

Q: All this - all this happened before the - before we got here (unintelligible).

A: Yeah, my husband's one of the ones that called...

Q: Okay.

A: ...the cops. And, um...

Q: What was he screaming?

A: Ah, he was - but first you couldn't understand what he was saying. And then he started saying kill me. He was saying fuck you to cars stopping.

Q: And he was in the middle of the street doing all of this?

A: Yes, out in the middle the street. Well at first he's like - he's on the curb...

Q: Uh-huh.

A: ...then he started to come towards the middle of the street and like he was running - he's not running but going in front of cars I'm surprised he didn't get hit..

128 finally stopped. Like I saw that he finally stopped.
