On 10-31-08, at approximately 2300 hours, I received a phone call at home from Sgt. Rossi. I responded to 7875 Cypress Ave. regarding a subject who died after being taken into custody by officers. Upon arrival, I was assigned to investigate the crime scene.

The altercation between Officers Ratkovich and Koehler, and S-Acevedo took place in the street in front of 7875 Cypress Ave. The crime scene consisted of Cypress Avenue between the addresses of 7875 and 7857. The area was lit by a street light which was on the south side of Cypress Avenue, across from 7875.

Scene investigation

Evidence Technician McKay-Davis and I processed the crime scene. McKay-Davis video recorded and photographed the scene. McKay-Davis collected evidence from the scene.

Vehicles inside crime scene

Six vehicles, including three Riverside Police Units were parked inside the crime scene. The vehicles are listed as follows:

Riverside Police Unit 3746 – Parked in the middle of Cypress Avenue to the front of 7875 Cypress. The vehicle was facing west.

Riverside Police Unit 3612 – Parked in the westbound lane of Cypress Avenue, between 7875 and 7857. The vehicle was facing in a North/West direction.

Riverside Police Unit 3620 – Parked on the South side of Cypress Avenue, pulling into the apartment complex across from 7857.

1988 Toyota Corolla (License [REDACTED]) – Parked along the North curb of Cypress Avenue, facing West, in front of 7857.

1992 Honda Accord (License [REDACTED]) – Parked along the North curb of Cypress Avenue, facing West, in front of 7875.

1996 Honda Civic (License [REDACTED]) – Parked along the South curb of Cypress Avenue, facing East, across from 7875.

The engines for Riverside Police Units 3746 and 3612 were still running at the time of the investigation.

According to officers, the video camera in Riverside Police Unit 3746 was activated at the time of the altercation. Lt. Loftus arrived to attempt to retrieve the video of the incident. Technical difficulties prevented the video to be retrieved at the scene. The video will be retrieved at a later date.

Evidence at crime scene

According to preliminary information, the altercation between Officers Ratkovich and Koehler and S-Acevedo occurred on the street in front of Riverside Police Unit 3746.

A pair of black "Vox" shoes was found on the street in front of Riverside Police Unit 3746. The shoes belong to S-Acevedo. It is unknown if they came off during the altercation and arrest, or when he was being treated by paramedics.

Two silver colored metal caps from the taser cartridge were found on the street in front of Riverside Police Unit 3746.

The ASP batons belonging to Officers Ratkovich and Koehler were found inside Riverside Police unit 3746, on the center console between the front seats. One ASP baton was fully extended and the other was collapsed. Sgt. Blomdahl stated that the ASP batons were originally on the street when S-Acevedo was taken into custody. They were picked up by officers and secured in the front seat of Unit 3746.

Evidence Technician McKay-Davis photographed and collected all evidence.
