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INJURIES:

V/ [REDACTED] had numerous bruises on her face, head, arms, legs/ thighs, and back and a long laceration on her left lower leg (approx 10-12" long) that did not require sutures.

PHOTOGRAPHS:

V-1 refused photos, however, hospital staff obtained photos before I arrived. V-1 refused to sign a medical release form to obtain the photos.

OTHER:

Attending Kaiser physician: Dr. Mazur

NARRATIVE:

On 11/08/11, at approximately 1351 hours, I was dispatched to Kaiser Hospital reference a female who was assaulted and bruised all over. Upon arriving at Kaiser Hospital, I briefly spoke with the nurse who directed me to the victim's sister in the waiting area. I contacted the victim's sister, O-1/ [REDACTED] first to obtain any information she may have, since V/ [REDACTED] was not forthcoming with them or hospital staff. O-1/ [REDACTED] is the closest sibling with V/ [REDACTED] and received a call from another family member that V/ [REDACTED] was at her ex-boyfriend's house and badly beaten. Today around 12 noon, O-1/ [REDACTED] went to the ex-boyfriend's house at 7680 Gramercy to check on her sister and saw that she was bruised all over and had a long cut on her leg. O-1/ [REDACTED] was able to convince V/ [REDACTED] to get her laceration checked at the hospital to avoid infection, though she was reluctant to go. O-1/ [REDACTED] asked her sister what happened and how her leg got cut. V/ [REDACTED] told O-1/ [REDACTED] her leg was cut from jumping over a fence, but wouldn't elaborate why she was jumping over a fence or where. O-1/ [REDACTED] believes she was escaping from her current (not ex) boyfriend's house and believes he is the person who assaulted her.

O-1/ [REDACTED] said V/ [REDACTED] sometimes disappears for days at a time and has a past history of drug use. V/ [REDACTED] went through a rehab program and is repeating the same behavior when she used drugs in the past. V/ [REDACTED] lives with her mother and has two children, ages 4 and 6, who reside with her. V/ [REDACTED] mother takes care of the kids when she's not there. O-1/ [REDACTED] said she's a good mother to her kids. O-1/ [REDACTED] has seen bruises on V/ [REDACTED] in the past since she has been dating her current boyfriend. O-1/ [REDACTED] and her sisters did some research into their sister's boyfriend (Danny Bond) and discovered that he is a registered sex offender. They found him by checking into Meagan's Law.

V/ [REDACTED] refused to tell anyone what happened or how she received her injuries. She denied being afraid of who did it, refused to identify the person, and why or where it happened. She did tell me that it happened last night, but would not disclose a location. Some of the bruises appeared new and others a bit older. She had multiple bruises on her face (jaw, entire forehead, cheeks) including two black eyes. Both upper and lower extremities had several bruises and on her mid-back area. Both sides of her outer thighs (below hip) were severely bruised causing her to walk differently. O-1/ [REDACTED] saw she had a difficult time walking. V/ [REDACTED] denied any sexual abuse. She would only admit that the cut on her lower left leg was from a fence. Before I arrived, she allowed a nurse to take photographs of her injuries as part of the medical care, but refused to allow me to take them. She also refused to sign a medical release and was adamant she did not want anything done. V/ [REDACTED] denied her boyfriend (Danny Bond) did it. She only made statements that she "wouldn't go back" and "It won't happen again", but wouldn't say more. She did admit to using drugs again and didn't plan on returning home until her bruises were gone so that her kids don't see her like that.

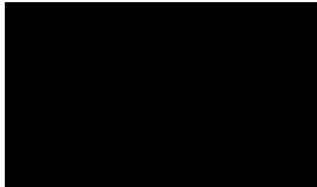
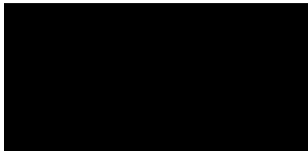

Narrative:

I was assigned this case for follow-up investigation. There are four police reports associated with this case, including mine. The four reports include the initial report, two supplemental reports associated with the initial, and a restraining order report taken when the victim filed her restraining order with the Riverside Police Department (Report number P11166579).

Officer M. Tryon was the investigating officer who completed the initial police report. The day Officer Tryon met and interviewed the victim she (V-1) provided little information and would not explain how she was injured.

The following day Officer C. Arnold was dispatched to re-contact V-1 and obtain additional information. Officer Arnold photographed V-1 and her injuries and obtained a statement from V-1 who named the person that assaulted her. V-1 told Officer Arnold she was assaulted by Danny James Bond and provided Bond's birthdate, 07-27-1973.

During follow-up on this case I spoke to Officer Arnold about her contact with V-1. Officer Arnold said V-1 was reluctant to provide information and vague on details. Officer Arnold told me she was in possession of her Puma audio-recorder that day in order to record V-1's statement, a practice she normally does when interviewing victims of domestic violence. said she realized after the contact was over that the recorder failed to activate so she did not obtain a recorded statement.

I asked Officer Arnold if V-1 provided Danny Bond's entire name and correct birthdate. Officer Arnold said V-1 provided this information on her own. I asked Officer Arnold if V-1 provided Bond's address of 7680 Gramercy Place. Officer Arnold said V-1 did not know the address but described the house and its location. Officer Arnold said V-1 told her it was a blue house at the corner of Gramercy and Montgomery. V-1 said the house had exterior cameras with wires down the side of the house. V-1 also said Bond possessed a gun and stated he would never go back to jail.

Officer Arnold requested additional officers to assist her in contacting Danny Bond. The officers drove to the location V-1 described and determined it was 7680 Gramercy Place. Officer Arnold said the house matched the description V-1 gave and there was an exterior surveillance camera as V-1 described. Officer Arnold knocked on the door but no one answered. Officer Arnold told me that V-1's injuries were likely the worst she has seen on a domestic violence victim.

On 11-21-2011 I called the telephone number listed for V-1. I reached [REDACTED] who identified herself as V-1's mother. [REDACTED] told me V-1 was not home. I provided my name and contact number and explained the reason for calling. [REDACTED] said she would pass along the information. [REDACTED] said V-1 obtained a restraining order against Bond. I asked [REDACTED] if she ever saw Bond before and she said she never met him. I asked [REDACTED] if V-1 ever lived with Bond. [REDACTED] believed V-1 stayed at Bond's house on and off but she had no direct knowledge of that.

On 11-23-2011 I drove to [REDACTED]'s residence located at 5376 Warren Street. I went there looking for V-1 but learned she was not home. I spoke to [REDACTED] a person. [REDACTED] told me she is actually V-1's Aunt however she says she is V-1's mother because she raised V-1 from childhood.

[REDACTED] said she has been raising V-1's children because V-1 runs the streets and is known to use drugs. V-1's two children were present and I briefly met them. Their names are [REDACTED]. The children appeared happy and outgoing. They were well dressed and the house looked orderly. [REDACTED] said she took it upon herself to raise V-1's children and provide a safe home for them to live in.

I asked [REDACTED] if she knew how to contact V-1. [REDACTED] said V-1 had been staying at [REDACTED]'s house so her children would not see her injuries. [REDACTED] is the paternal grandmother of V-1's children. [REDACTED] said V-1 was no longer staying at [REDACTED]'s house and here whereabouts were unknown. I asked for [REDACTED]'s address and V-1 provided directions to the location [REDACTED].

I drove to [REDACTED] where I spoke to [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] allowed me inside her apartment and we discussed what was going on. [REDACTED] said V-1 told her Danny Bond was the person who assaulted her however [REDACTED] did not want to get involved or testify in court. [REDACTED]

told me V-1 was badly beat up and walked really slow from her injuries. [REDACTED] said her daughters looked Danny Bond up on the internet because he was a registered sex offender. [REDACTED] said V-1 helped them do this and they printed out his information and photo. I asked if they gave the print out to Officer Arnold but they seemed unsure who they gave it to.

On 12-05-2011 I called [REDACTED] again and asked if she spoke to V-1. [REDACTED] said she had not seen V-1 however V-1 was aware I was looking for her. [REDACTED] said the Sheriff's Department returned V-1's restraining order because they were unable to serve it to Danny Bond.

On 12-06-2011 I conducted an audio-recorded telephone interview with [REDACTED] who is V-1's sister. The following is a summary of [REDACTED]'s statement:

Rosemary said she suspects Danny Bond assaulted V-1 however she does not know this for certain. V-1 was unwilling to talk about what happened or say who did it. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] (V-1's other sister) were the ones who drove V-1 to the hospital. [REDACTED] helped check V-1 in and the two sisters waited for V-1 while she was being treated.

[REDACTED] said V-1 walked like, "An old grandma" that day. She said they used a wheelchair to wheel V-1 into the hospital because V-1 was moving so slowly. She said V-1 was moving slowly because of her injuries and not walking properly. I asked [REDACTED] if V-1 normally moved like that and she said no. I asked [REDACTED] if she was present while V-1 spoke to Officer Tryon at the hospital. [REDACTED] said she did not hear Officer Tryon's interview with V-1 however she was present the following day when an officer photographed V-1's injuries.

On 12-06-2011 Detective Vaughan and I drove to [REDACTED]'s residence looking for V-1. We spoke to [REDACTED] who stated V-1 had not been around however V-1 knew I was looking for her. [REDACTED] said V-1 was back together with Bond and possibly staying at his home.

On 12-07-2011 I called Riverside Child Protective Services and obtained the name of the CPS worker who interviewed V-1 about this incident. His name is Joseph Weisenberger and he works out of the Riverside DPSS Central Avenue location.

I telephoned Weisenberger and asked for any case notes or reports he might have relating to his contact with V-1. Weisenberger faxed me a one page document he completed reference the contact. I read the document and V-1 names Danny Bond as the person who assaulted her. V-1 likely provided more details to Weisenberger about the assault than she did to any of the Riverside Police Officers she spoke with. I attached a copy of Weisenberger's faxed document to my report.

I located a copy of the restraining order V-1 obtained against Danny Bond. The restraining order was granted November 10th, 2011 through Riverside Superior Court Family Law Division. The case number is RIV1101361.

I read the order and its statement of facts. Line 23 of the DV 100 form talks about the most recent abuse. V-1 states, "He kept hitting me on the face and legs...I'm always walking on egg shells...I talked back to him and that's when he started slapping me and hitting me... his friend showed up and that's when I jumped out the window and ran to my mother in laws house."

Line 1 of the DV 101 form talks about abuse sustained approximately two week prior. V-1 states, "he head butted me...we were just talking and I guess I said something wrong and that's when he grabbed my head with both hands and head butted me."

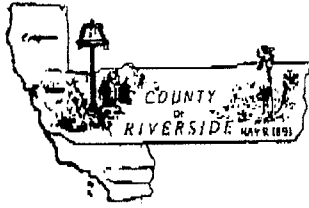
I spoke with Riverside Police Department records employee Donna Granillo about Danny Bond and his sex offender registration. Granillo checked and confirmed Danny Bond's last registration. Granillo told me Bond registered with the Riverside Police Department on July 25th, 2011. He provided his address as 7680 Gramercy Place (Riverside) and stated it was his grandparent's house.

I completed an arrest warrant declaration against Danny James Bond alleging the crime of 245(a)(1) PC and submitted the case to the District Attorney's Office.

Ms. Gutierrez interview

This is an insert of my interview with the mother, [REDACTED]
[REDACTED] on November 9, 2011:

I was able to observe that the mother, [REDACTED] had a black right eye, her left forehead and cheek was also very visibly bruised, and [REDACTED] lifted her left pant leg so I could see a large vertical cut going up the inside of her leg.

As to the allegations that she was physically abused by someone to the point where she had to go to the hospital, [REDACTED] stated that it was true. She originally stated that she went to her boyfriend's home on Monday; he got upset, and "beat" her up. She was reluctant to tell me her boyfriend's name, but after some discussion and encouragement from the paternal grandmother, [REDACTED] she stated that his name is Daniel James Bond. Ms. [REDACTED] provided me a print out from Family Watchdog that identified Mr. Bond as being convicted of 288a(c)(2), oral copulation with force, violence, etc. His DOB is: 07/27/1973. Mr. Bond lives at 7680 Gramercy Place in Riverside.

[REDACTED] then stated that she went to see Mr. Bond on Monday, and she upset him by something that she said. This caused him to hit, and slap her to the point where she was hurt. She stated that this was the third time in the last two weeks since she has been dating him that she has been physically abused by Mr. Bond. She stated that Mr. Bond will get angry often, and very easily. She stated that Mr. Bond did not close the door to the bedroom where she was physically abused, but it was understood that if she attempted to leave the home he would hurt her more. She stated that early Tuesday morning, when it was still dark, she snuck out of the bedroom window, and jump the back fence. She stated that when she jumped the fence she cut her left leg. She ran to a friend's home, who took her to the paternal grandmother's home. From there she went to the hospital. She stated that she is staying at the grandmother's home at the moment because she doesn't want her children to see her bruised and cut.

Your Affiant is Michael O'Boyle, a detective for the Riverside Police Department. I have been a law enforcement officer for 16 years and have the following law enforcement experience:

- Reserve Level II Police Officer City of Banning – one year
- Patrol Officer Riverside Police Department – seven years
- Bicycle Patrol Officer Riverside Police Department - two years
- Police and Corrections Team Riverside Police Department - two years
- Detective Riverside Police Department – four years

I have been employed as a Peace Officer for the Riverside Police Department since July 05, 1996. My present assignment is detective, assigned to the Centralized Investigations Bureau, Domestic Violence Unit. Prior to this assignment, I spent approximately nineteen months working as a property crimes detective. I was promoted to the rank of detective in October 2007.

As a Riverside Police Officer I have worked as a member of the Riverside Police Department's Police and Corrections Team, Bicycle Enforcement Team, and as a patrol officer. In 2009 I successfully completed a 16 hour training course dedicated to domestic violence and sexual assault for first responders. This course was sponsored by the San Diego Regional Training Center.

In 2010 I taught California Highway Patrol Officers how to understand, interpret, and enforce domestic violence restraining orders.

In 2011 I successfully completed a 16 hour training course designed to teach law enforcement officers how to investigate officer involved domestic violence.

I regularly review incident reports related to family violence and perform follow-up investigations. I make arrests, interview suspects, and present cases to the district attorney's office for a variety of offenses, including domestic violence and child abuse.

Case Details:

On November 8th, 2011 [REDACTED] arrived at Kaiser Permanente Hospital's Riverside location for treatment. [REDACTED] appeared severely beaten and the hospital staff believed she had been assaulted. The Riverside Police Department was notified and Officer Tryon was dispatched to investigate. [REDACTED] would not divulge the mechanism of her injury or say if she had been assaulted however Officer Tryon talked to [REDACTED] family members who believed her boyfriend assaulted her. The following day [REDACTED] contacted Riverside Police Department to provide additional information. Officer Arnold was dispatched to talk to [REDACTED] who admitted she had been assaulted by her boyfriend, Danny James Bond. Officer Arnold photographed [REDACTED] and her injuries that day and Officer Arnold completed a police report documenting [REDACTED] statement. The case was assigned to me for follow-up investigation. I spoke to Officer Arnold who said [REDACTED] was reluctant to provide details. I tried to locate [REDACTED] to interview her further however I could not find her. I have viewed photo images of [REDACTED] injuries and consider them fairly severe in nature. I spoke to [REDACTED] sister [REDACTED] who said she took [REDACTED] to the hospital that day. [REDACTED] told me [REDACTED] moved very slowly from her injuries. [REDACTED] told me [REDACTED] walked like, "An old grandma" that day. [REDACTED] used a wheelchair to wheel [REDACTED] into the emergency room for treatment. I believe a review of [REDACTED] medical records for her hospital visit that day will assist this investigation in determining whether a felony has been committed or not. I believe the injuries [REDACTED] sustained may rise to the level of assault with force likely to cause great bodily injury therefore I am asking the court to grant this search warrant so I may obtain the medical records.

[REDACTED] wished her identity remain confidential per 293(a) PC therefore I am asking the court to seal any part of the search warrant that reveals her identity.

I pray that a Search Warrant be issued based upon the aforementioned facts, for the seizure of said property, or any part thereof, between the hours of 7:00 A.M. and 10:00 P.M., good cause being shown thereof, and the same be brought before this Magistrate or retained subject to the order of the court, or of any court in which the offense(s) in respect to which the property of things taken, triable, pursuant to Section 1536 of the Penal Code,
