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1 NARRATIVE:

3 On Tuesday, 12-31-13, at about 1133 hours, partner Ofc. Soria and I were on patrol in a marked police  
4 unit, call sign Z410. We were driving in the area of Tyler/Hole and were monitoring the radio and heard a  
5 fellow officer ask for assistance in the area of Arlington Park located at 3860 Van Buren. We responded  
6 to the scene. Once we arrived on scene I observed both Ofc. Miranda and Ofc. Asbury had their guns  
7 drawn on S1 and W1 / [REDACTED]. S1 was lying on his back by the kids playing area. W1 / [REDACTED] was  
8 about 4 feet away from him and was lying on her stomach. Ofc. Soria and I grabbed the female and put  
9 her in the back of our unit. Due to not knowing if she was a suspect I placed handcuffs on her for ours and  
10 her safety. I drove the unit by the tennis courts and awaiting directions from supervision.

11  
12 At about 1200 hours, Sgt. Russell instructed me to transport W1 / [REDACTED] to the Magnolia Station. When  
13 I arrived at the station I removed the handcuffs from W1 / [REDACTED] and escorted her to Interview room #1.  
14 While at the station I activated my PUMA audio recorder. I remained in custody of W1 / [REDACTED] until  
15 Detectives arrived on scene and interviewed her.

16  
17 At about 1545 hours, W1 / [REDACTED] mother arrived at the station to pick up her daughter. W1 / [REDACTED]  
18 was released to the custody of her mother.

19  
20 Refer to audio reference what W1 / [REDACTED] was saying. During the time we spent at the station she was  
21 crying, yelling, and blaming herself. She was loud and at sometimes belligerent.
