62. Narrative of Supplemental Report

On January 28, 2009, I conducted a limited technical inspection of a Glock model 22 pistol, accompanying ammunition, and magazines at the request of Detective Richard Wheeler. A limited technical inspection consists of a field-strip level disassembly (not a complete armorer's disassembly), inspection of the parts thus exposed, reassembly, and finally, a function test of the various operating systems of the firearm per factory guidelines.

The pistol (Item WL002) has a serial number of [REDACTED] and is issued to Officer Dave Taylor. Additional items consist of the following magazines and specified quantities of ammunition: Item WL004 - a single round of ammunition listed as being from the chamber of Officer Taylor's pistol; Item WL005 - three Glock 22 magazines and 45 rounds of ammunition; and Item WL003 - a Glock 22 magazine and 9 rounds of ammunition. **It should be noted that the packing label for WL003 states 12 rounds of ammunition were included, but at the time of my inspection, the bag only contained 9 rounds. Detective Wheeler about this and was informed that the Riverside DOJ lab retained three rounds for testing purposes, so all ammunition remains accounted for. All ammunition inspected was verified to be Winchester RA40T, which is RPD's authorized duty round. Upon inspection under Glock factory guidelines, I found this pistol to be completely within factory specifications – as far as can be determined by the partial disassembly of a limited technical inspection – and this pistol successfully passed all of the Glock factory-recommended function checks. I measured the trigger pull of this pistol five times with a Lyman electronic trigger pull gauge which recorded an average trigger pull-weight of seven pounds, eleven ounces. While there is minor cosmetic damage to the right side of the pistol's grip, the firearm and all magazines appear to be in serviceable condition.

Based on this limited technical inspection, this pistol does not appear to contain any unauthorized aftermarket parts or modifications, and appears to be in good working order. Range records indicate that this pistol is due for an annual-level detail inspection and cleaning, and I would recommend that it be returned to the range at the conclusion of the investigation so that this service can be performed before it is returned to duty status.
