I am currently a detective in the RPD Gang Intelligence unit. On 09-13-13, Det. Collopy and I were working on an unrelated case. We received a phone call from our supervisor Sgt. Brian Smith. Sgt. Smith informed us there had been an officer involved shooting at 2395 10th. He told us to respond to the location and contact the on scene supervisor Sgt. Gary Toussaint.

I drove to the location and arrived on scene at about 2145 hours. Sgt. Toussaint asked Det. Collopy, Det. Adam Levesque, and I to get a statement from the family members present if possible. When we went to speak to the family they were sitting near the driveway for the residence. As we approached the family, I could see that they were visibly upset. They were crying and when we were a short distance away, several of the family members yelled at us and said they did not want to speak to us.

When we arrived at where the family was sitting, a female, later identified as RP/Thalia Jimenez, said she would speak with me. RP/Thalia Jimenez and I walked a short distance away to talk. I recorded the conversation with my digital recorder. The recording was later down loaded into the departmental system.

RP/Thalia Jimenez's statement:

RP/Thalia Jimenez was visibly upset. She could not give detailed answers to the questions I was asking. About five minutes into the interview, she told me she couldn't answer any further questions and wanted to return to her mother. My interview with RP/Thalia Jimenez lasted about seven minutes. The following is a summary of the interview.

RP/Thalia Jimenez told me she is S/Hector Jimenez's daughter. RP/Thalia Jimenez told me her father was released from Parkview Hospital today at about 1400 hours. RP/Thalia Jimenez said when her father was released from the hospital he came home and starting drinking beer and taking his medications.

RP/Thalia Jimenez said S/Hector Jimenez was inside the home and he started going "crazy." She told me he started cutting himself with a knife in front of the family. When S/Hector Jimenez went outside, RP/Thalia Jimenez called the police.

I asked RP/Thalia Jimenez if she could physically see what happened after the officers arrived. She told me she could not see what happened when the officers shot S/Hector Jimenez. She could not remember what the officers were telling her dad. She does remember hearing her father telling the officers that he has cancer. RP/Thalia Jimenez told me that she did not know if her father stood up or if the officers just told her that to make her feel better about him being shot.

At the end of the interview, RP/Thalia Jimenez was upset that the officers shot her father. She could not understand why the officers didn't use a taser or just take the knife away from him instead of shooting him. RP/Thalia Jimenez ended the conversation.

Narrative:

After speaking to RP/Thalia Jimenez, I could not find any other family members that wanted to speak to me. Det. Sanfalippo asked me to interview AMR EMT O/Knittel.

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O/Knittel's statement:

I spoke to O/Knittel at the crime scene. O/Knittel was working as AMR Unit #3354. When they received the call, they staged on Victoria near 11th St. until they were called in. O/Knittel said he did not see the shooting. He believes the shooting had already occurred prior to them being called in.

O/Knittel said AMR and RFD arrived at about the same time. They went into the crime scene to approach S/Hector Jimenez. S/Hector Jimenez did not have a pulse and was not breathing when O/Knittel examined him. O/Knittel told me it looked like one of the rounds exited through the back of S/Hector Jimenez's head. O/Knittel and the RFD medic (O/Knittel did not know his name) pronounced S/Hector Jimenez at the scene, so they did not transport him to a hospital.

Narrative:

After speaking to O/Knittel, I cleared the scene at about 2330 hours. I assisted Det. Collopy with writing a search warrant for the residence.
