1 Narrative:

2 On Saturday, January 07, 2012 approximately 1625 hours, partner officer J. Adcox and I were assigned to
3 the Riverside Police Department (RPD) Police And Corrections Team (PACT). We responded to 10745
4 Cypress Ave. in the City and County of Riverside, CA. reference "Shots fired" broadcast on the radio.
5

6 Upon arrival, I saw officers Miranda, Putnam and Espinosa in the rear yard of the residence. There was a
7 group of people yelling at them. I saw a male adult down on the ground, lying on his stomach. I assisted
8 in securing the scene and keeping the group of people away from the officers and the suspect.

9 O/Margadonna appeared especially hostile toward the officers. He was told to back away, which he did
10 do, but then attempted to flee the scene. At that point, I did not know his involvement in the incident, so I
11 detained him. I later spoke with O/Margadonna and received his statement (see statement below). His
12 statement was recorded on my department issued "PUMA" digital audio recorder.

14 I then assisted in conducting a safety sweep of the out buildings on the property and then held a perimeter
15 spot on the scene and later transported Officer Putnam's vehicle back to RPD Lincoln Station.

17 Statements:

18 O/Margadonna stated he is a family friend, and arrived at the residence today at 1500 hours. He said he
19 saw the entire incident involving the officers. O/Margadonna stated when officers arrived on scene; they
20 went to the rear yard with their guns drawn. S1 approached them with something in his hand. He heard
21 officers order S1 to drop what he was holding in his hand. I asked O/Margadonna, exactly what the
22 officers told him to drop, but he said he did not hear what they said. Later during our interview,
23 O/Margadonna said he heard the officers order S1 to drop a knife. O/Margadonna said he did not believe
24 S1 was holding a knife, but rather some tools and a piece of wood, which he was using to hold up the
25 hood of a vehicle he was working on. S1 did not drop the items he was holding. Officers "Tazed" S1.
26 Whatever it was that he was holding; went flying out of his hand, but he did not throw it at the officers.
27 The officers then fired 6-12 shots. S1 fell to the ground. He heard S1 ask for water. More officers then
28 arrived on scene.
