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Narrative:

On 01/07/12, at approximately 1624 hours, I was working routine patrol in a marked police vehicle while in full police uniform (assigned as C322). At that time, I responded to 10745 Cypress Avenue for a report of shots fired put out from an Officer who was on scene, and who needed immediate assistance. I responded from the area of Hillside / Central, and I arrived on scene at approximately 1627 hours. There were multiple Officers on scene already. I went to the back yard where S1/Ledezma was lying on the ground getting treated by AMR and RFD personnel. There was a knife on the ground in the area where S1/Ledezma was located. Sgt. Banks told me to remain with the knife. Once AMR removed S1/Ledezma from the scene (to transport him to RCH), and RFD cleared the scene, crime scene tape was placed around the location of the incident. The crime scene was then secured. I then left the knife on the ground and took up a position on the North side of the house, which was the rear of the house. I stood next to the rear door to the house, which was located on the North / West corner of the house. (the 2/3 corner) I stood there to help preserve the crime scene and to avoid anyone from tampering with the evidence which was located in the back yard. I remained there until I was told (by Sgt. Banks) that I could clear the scene. I cleared the scene at approximately 2000 hours.
