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1 **Narrative:**

2 On 01-07-12 at approximately 1620 Hours, Partner Detective Jones and I were monitoring the radio when we heard
3 officers advised "shots fired" and the officers also asking for additional units at the location. Dispatch advised the
4 officers were at 10745 Cypress Avenue. We were in the area and immediately responded to the scene.

6 PAC Team members Officer Adcox, Officer Leone, Detective Jones and I were the first on scene. We ran to the
7 rear yard of the residence to assist the units. As I ran towards the officers I could see a Cadet or Explorer, Officer
8 Miranda, Officer Putman and Officer Espinoza standing near a vehicle and pointing their guns at a subject who
9 was lying on the ground. I also saw at least four adults yelling at the officers and attempting to get to the subject
10 who was on the ground. I asked the individuals to step back and get away from the officers.
11

12 At first the individuals did not want to cooperate but eventually followed my orders. Once the adults stepped back,
13 additional officers arrived. I left the adults with another officer. I walked up to the officers and helped them place
14 S1 in custody. RFD was on scene and started to provide S1 with medical aid. In the meantime, myself and other
15 officers cleared the shed, shacks, and the main residence.

17 Once the residence was cleared, I returned outside and assisted Detective Jones in locating evidence. We placed
18 yellow evidence markers next to every shell casing located, the taser, a knife, pipes, and the area where the suspect
19 was lying when we arrived. By this time, S1 had already been moved and transported by AMR.

21 Evidence Tech S. Lane arrived on scene. I walked the scene with her to assist in the video taping of the crime
22 scene. The wind was very strong and had moved some evidence prior to her arrival. I pointed out where the evidence
23 and the evidence markers were located before the wind moved them.

25 We remained on scene to help secure the perimeter. At approximately 2230 Hours, I drove Officer Miranda's
26 vehicle to the Lincoln Station. I verified that the COBAN video had been uploaded and the system was shutdown.

28 We returned to the scene and continued maintaining the perimeter. Later we were advised we could clear from the
29 scene.

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
