NARRATIVE:

On 02-23-15, at about 2128 hours, I was working a special detail in full uniform in an unmarked police vehicle. I was parked in the area of Lime Ave. and University Ave when I heard an Officer (C236) frantically broadcast over the radio "shots fired". I immediately checked on my mobile computer the location of the call as my partner (Officer Herington) began driving towards the beat C236 works. More information was broadcasted over the radio stating the suspect's description and direction of travel. Information was also broadcasted the suspect possessed a shotgun and had fired at several officers. Officer Herington and I arrived in the area of Cottage and Park Ave. to take a perimeter spot.

INVESTIGATIVE ACTIONS:

I exited the vehicle and learned the suspect was last seen heading west on Pleasant Ave. I ran towards the intersection of Grove and Pleasant Ave. when I arrived in the area I was told the suspect had entered a residence and had shot himself.

I was then assigned to secure the location where the initial shooting took place (2865 Prospect). When I arrived at that location, I assisted several officers with conducting a safety sweep of the residence. The residence was cleared and the location was secured for further investigation.

I then assisted officers with conducting a canvas of the area. I went to [REDACTED] which is the residence to the immediate east of the primary residence. I knocked on the door and contacted O1/[REDACTED] and O2/[REDACTED]

STATEMENTS:

The following statement was audio recorded using my department issued recorder. The following is not an exact transcript of the statement given by O1 and O2. The audio recording was later downloaded into the system at the Magnolia Station.

O1 told me he was in his living room watching TV with his wife (O2). O1 could hear a subject he recognized as "Steven" fighting with somebody outside. O2 told O1 they should call the police. O1 said the fighting next door was a usual occurrence and disagreed with O2. O1 and O2 then heard a female say "Put the gun away". They then heard what they believed to be a gun shot. After hearing the gun shot O1 called the police. O1 said he and his wife went to their room. O1 heard more fighting after the gun shot. Shortly after that there was no more fighting and was quite. O1 heard what he described as the brakes of a police car to the front of his house. He then heard loud knocking on the door and "police". Both O1 and O2 heard yelling and more gunshots. O1 said he heard about four or five gunshots, followed by what he described as a loud shotgun. O1 and O2 said they took cover in their closet after hearing the gunshots.

While speaking to O1 and O2 I noticed their kitchen window had what appeared to be a bullet hole. The kitchen window is located on the north side of the residence towards the west wall. I followed the trajectory and saw a strike mark in the top of the door frame between the kitchen and living room. There appeared to be a bullet/pellet inside of the strike mark.

After speaking with O1 and O2, I advised them a Detective would be contacting them for further questioning. I also told them an ID Technician would be responding to their residence to process/recover evidence.
