1 Details:

2 On 02-23-15 I was working uniformed patrol as a field supervisor for the North and East NPC's within the City  
3 and County of Riverside, Ca. At 2139 hours I heard a radio broadcast by Officers D. Macias and S. Weddle  
4 advising that shots had been fired at 2865 Prospect. I responded to the scene from the downtown area.  
5

6 Upon arrival I assumed overall management of the incident. I located Officer Macias on Park Ave near the west  
7 access to the alleyway between Park and Grove and north of Prospect. I confirmed that both Officer Weddle and  
8 Macias were not injured. Officer Macias provided me with a brief public safety statement and indicated the  
9 suspect had fled the scene and was still outstanding. This information was broadcasted to assisting units.

11 While attempting to gain additional information related to public safety matters I was informed the suspect had  
12 possibly entered a residence at 2786 Pleasant and there was shooting inside the location. I responded to this  
13 location with a team of officers. Upon arrival I learned that other officers and a supervisor had just finished  
14 clearing the residence. I was informed by Sergeant Reddick that the suspect was located in a back room and he  
15 was obviously deceased due to what appeared to be a self-inflicted gunshot wound to the head.

17 To ensure this was in fact our suspect from the officer involved shooting, I directed Officer Macias to respond to  
18 this residence for suspect identification. He positively identified the deceased as the suspect who was shooting at  
19 him and Officer Weddle. The residence was then secured for further investigation. I again confirmed we had no  
20 other outstanding suspects. The location of the officer involved shooting, path of the suspect, and evidence was  
21 secured by assisting officers.

23 I briefed the acting watch commander, Sergeant Stump, and the graveyard watch commander, Lieutenant Dinco  
24 of the circumstances surrounding this incident. I later provided the various investigative units with a brief of the  
25 incident. I was relieved of my duties at 0700 hours at which time I cleared the scene.
