Narrative Continued:

I began a canvas of the two houses West of the O.I.S. scene. At [REDACTED] I spoke with O-1/Garcia. She stated that she heard (3) shots on the East side of her house and then approx. 1 minute later heard (3) more shots that sounded like they came from behind her house. She then heard what she believed to be a car drive by the front of the residence at a high rate of speed.

At [REDACTED] I spoke with O-2/Sosa. She stated that her family was watching TV and heard (5) or (6) gun shots. They retreated into their bedrooms after hearing the shots.

The interviews were recorded on my department issued PUMA recorder. I downloaded the recordings at the Lincoln Street Station.
