62. Narrative of Supplemental Report On 05-10-11 at 1800 hours, dispatch broadcast a report of shots heard at 11532 Trailway Dr. I advised dispatch that I was enroute at 1801 hours. At 1802 hours I heard the officer at the scene broadcast of victims down and "shots fired". I responded code three and arrived on scene at 1805 hours. At approximately 1806 hours I took K9 Marco out of the car and was met by Sgt. Corbett approximately ten yards west of my unit on Trailway Dr. Sgt. Corbett was the on scene supervisor who briefed me. Sgt. Corbett advised me that he had two victims down across the street and he pointed to the suspect (S-1). I saw that the suspect was lying on the ground on his stomach with his hands underneath him at the driveway curb line area in front of 11531 Trailway Dr. I knew approaching the suspect in the open would be a safety concern. This person to my understanding had shot at least one person and been involved in a gun fight with the responding officer. The suspect was reportedly still breathing, possibly armed and did not respond to verbal commands. The suspects hands were underneath him and not visible. 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Sgt. Corbett requested that I deploy the K9. Due to the urgent nature of the circumstance, the need to get aid to the victims and secure the suspect, I concurred with Sgt. Corbett's decision to tactically deploy K9 Marco for officer safety.

At approximately 1807 hours, from approximately fifty feet, I sent K9 Marco to the suspect on a apprehension command. K9 Marco bit the suspect on the right torso side area, apparently lost hold and then bit the suspect on the right tricep. The suspect did not move as myself and the arrest team officers approached the suspect. I gave K9 Marco the release command and had him lay down next to the suspect.

I saw a blue steel semi automatic handgun protruding from underneath the suspect and advised the other arrest team officers. Total time on both bites was six seconds.

I then used K9 Marco to assist officers in clearing the residences at 11532 and 11531 Trailway Dr.

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
