Incident Number: P11068393 On 05-10-11 at approximately 1800 hours, while sitting inside of the roll call room typing reports; partner Officer Castillo and I heard dispatch broadcast a call of shots fired at 11532 Trailway Dr. Lt. Charrette entered the Roll Call room and advised us to stand by. At approximately 1830 hours, Lt. Charrette re-entered the Roll Call and asked us to respond out to the crime scene. Upon arrival, we contacted Lt. Griffiths. He advised Officer Castillo and I to contact the surrounding residences and occupants; in order to obtain statements and information in regards to the incident. I contacted 'Dacosta residing at 11507 Trailway; and she provided me with the following information: W1/Dacosta advised on 05-10-11 at approximately 1755 hours, she was sitting in her office located on the south side of her residence speaking to some of her patients. W1/Dacosta continued by saying while she was inside of her office, she heard what she believed to be eight rounds from a firearm. I asked W1/Dacosta how she was certain the sounds she heard came from a firearm. W1/Dacosta advised her father is a former NYPD Officer and she knew what guns sounded like. W1/Dacosta said after she heard the first eight rounds, there was a brief pause. W1/Dacosta then heard approximately six more rounds. W1/Dacosta said after those six rounds were heard, there was a long pause. After that pause, W1/Dacosta told me she heard continuous shooting. W1/Dacosta stated she heard approximately thirty to forty rounds in total.

W1/Dacosta said the reason she stopped counting the number of rounds was because she called 911, ran out of her office, and ran up her stairs to the safety of her loft. W1/Dacosta did not state any further.

After speaking to W1/Dacosta, I walked to 11523 Trailway Dr. in order to make contact with the residents of that house. I knocked on the front door and announced my presence approximately four separate times. No one came to the door and it appeared no one was inside of the residence.

Shortly after I made no contact with anyone at 11523 Trailway Dr., Homicide Detectives took over the investigation and Officer Castillo and I were released from the crime scene.
