I contacted W1-Sabbarese and he told me the following: W1-Sabbarese said that he was standing in living area when he heard the sound of 9 shots coming from the front of the residence (front street). W1-Sabbarese said that at one point he thought that the sound was from fire crackers. W1-Sabbarese immediately walked to the front window and saw a subject (possible S1) two houses to the right.											VCLD ()

1 W1-Sabbarese said that the subject (S1) was two houses to the right (south/west) of his residence (see
2 initial report) holding a hand gun (pistol). W1-Sabbarese couldn't tell for sure who the subject was, but
3 said that it was a black male wearing a tan top and blue jeans. W1-Sabbarese then saw how S1 began
4 shooting in the direction of a pick-up truck (dark colored Dodge Ram) that was parked in front of (11532
5 Trailway Dr.). W1-Sabbarese said that he didn't see anyone getting shot as the suspect continued
6 shooting his weapon.

8 W1-Sabbarese then walked away from the window and told his wife (W2-Virginia) to call the police and
9 to take the children to the other side of his residence (spare room) and seek cover. W1-Sabbarese said
10 that he heard approximately 9 to 10 rounds fired after he walked away from the window. W1-Sabbarese
11 said that he was scared for his family because he was unsure of how many people were shooting at each
12 other. W1-Sabbarese then walked to the same room where his family was (spare room) and waited for the
13 police to respond. W1-Sabbarese could provide no further information of incident.

15 I then requested to talk to his wife (W2-Virginia) and she told me the following:

21 W2-Virginia said she was in the kitchen area baking some cookies when she heard approximately 5 – 6
22 shots fired. W2-Virginia said that at one point she thought that the sound was from some fire crackers,
23 but could not tell for certain. W2-Virginia said that her husband (W1) walked to the front window of his
24 residence to see what was going on outside. W2-Virginia then heard another set (4-6) shots fired and was
25 told by her husband to get the children to safety and to take them to the other side of the house (spare
26 room). W2-Virginia then took her children to the room and called the police. W2-Virginia said that she
27 didn't see any suspect(s) or victims shooting at each other. W2-Virginia could provide no further
28 information on the incident.

30 I provided W1-Sabbarese and W2-Virginia with the phone number of the police station and requested
31 them to call if they remember any other details or information of the incident.

33 During the investigation Homicide Detectives responded to the scene and took over the investigation (see
34 supplemental reports for details).

36 Officer Boulerville and I were properly relieved from the scene.
