**EVIDENCE:**

1. EKG printout.

**NARRATIVE:**

On 05-10-11, I was conducting surveillance on an unrelated incident in the area of Hillside and Arlington. At about 1810 hours, I heard an unknown officer put out a call of "shots fired" on Trailway Dr. in the City and County of Riverside. I started responding to the call.

I arrived on scene at about the same time as Officer Elliott and Officer Cash. We exited our vehicles and started towards the residence. Officer Cash and I were approaching the residence on the north sidewalk of Trailway Dr. AMR personnel stopped us and asked if we could remove the handcuffs from an unconscious person they were trying to treat. Officer Cash and I removed the handcuffs from the person. The person was later identified as S/Millon.

After assisting AMR, Officer Cash and I were assigned to the perimeter at 11532 Trailway. Officer Cash and I went to the rear of the residence and stayed there until other officers cleared the inside of the residence. I then went to the command post located near Trailway and Countrydale.

At the command post, I was assigned to escort Firefighter Kessel and Firefighter/Paramedic Jackson in to where the victims were located. We left the command post at about 1843 hours. I lead them west on Trailway until we reached the front yard of 11540 Trailway. We approached a black male lying face down in the grass near a tree. He was wearing a white shirt and black pants. I was later told that the person was V/Conley.

Kessel and Jackson approached the person believed to be V/Conley. They rolled him over face up and attached medical equipment and monitoring devices to him. Jackson told me the victim was deceased and handed me a print out from the portable EKG. I later photo copied the EKG printout and attached it to this report. The original was booked into property at the Magnolia Station. I then escorted them out of the crime scene the same way we came in. We exited the crime scene at about 1855 hours.

I was later asked to help set up EZ-ups to cover the victims. Several officers and I carried two EZ-ups to the driveway of 11540 Trailway. We set up the EZ-ups and then moved them over the bodies of the victims. I then left the crime scene. I stayed at the command post until Sgt. Hudson told me I was no longer needed.
