I am a Detective currently assigned to the Gang Intelligence Unit for Riverside PD. On 05-10-11 at approx. 1757 hrs I was monitoring my RPD radio and heard a call of a shooting occurring at 11532 Trailway Dr in the city and county of Riverside. I responded and arrived on scene at approx. 1810hrs. I was directed by Sergeant McCoy to follow AMR, who was transporting the suspect to RCH.

I followed AMR and we arrived at RCH at 1837 hrs. I contacted EMT Pollock (AMR #344) and he gave me the drivers license that was in the subjects pants pocket. The subject was identified as S/Virgil Anthony Millon (CDL [REDACTED]). He also provided me with a bag of clothing that was cut off S/Millon and a box of 357 magnum rounds that were in S/Millon's pants pocket.

S/Millon was taken into the ER Trauma room and worked on by Trauma Surgeon DR. William Alex and DR. Steven Patterson along with the entire trauma team. S/Millon was not conscious and did not make any statements.

DR. Patterson told me S/Millon suffered what appeared to be two through and through gunshot wounds to his right leg in the thigh area and a through and through gunshot wound to his head. He said the gunshots appeared to have entered S/Millon from the right side of his body and exited through the left. After initial treatment, S/Millon was taken from the trauma room to have a CAT scan performed on his head. He was brought back to the trauma room approx. 20 minutes later. The trauma team continued working on S/Millon until DR. Patterson pronounced his death at 1958 hrs.

Upon S/Millon expiring, I instructed the nurses to put paper bags to cover S/Millon's hands to preserve any evidence. S/Millon's body was placed in an isolated room to await the Coroner and evidence technician. Forensic Technician Sue Lane arrived at RCH at approx. 2105 hrs to process the evidence. Deputy Coroner Amy Roberts (ID# N3700) later arrived to process the body. Deputy Roberts took custody of S/Millon's body at 2240hrs. I provided her a briefing of the facts of the case. She provided me with Coroner Case #2011-04141. The bag of clothing and the ammunition was given to Forensic Tech. Lane for processing.
