**Narrative:**

On 5-10-11 at approximately 1800 hours I responded to a double murder/ officer involved shooting at 11532 Trailway Dr. Riverside, CA. Upon arrival Detective Rick Wheeler was assigned as the case agent, Detective Rick Cobb assisted and I was assigned to conduct interviews with Detectives Dave Smith and Mike Medici. The following is a summary of the recorded interview with W/ Andrew Baldwin and W/ Tonya Hawkins.

I responded to 11556 Trailway Dr. where I contacted W/ Andrew Baldwin and W/ Tonya Hawkins. W/ Baldwin said he lives at the residence with W/ Hawkins. W/ Baldwin said he used to talk with S/ Virgil Millon when he lived with V/ Arabella Bradford. W/ Baldwin said S/ Millon has been over his house looking at his home entertainment center. W/ Baldwin said he hasn't talked with S/ Millon in over a year though. He said S/ Millon has kept to himself, since the divorce with V/ Bradford. W/ Baldwin had seen V/ Bradford's new boyfriend V/ Malvin Conley, but he has never talked to him. W/ Baldwin knew they were all Corrections Deputies. W/ Baldwin didn't know how S/ Millon was taking the divorce or V/ Bradford dating another Corrections Deputy.

... Baldwin stated he was coming home from work about 1815 hours and was pulling into the gated complex when he started receiving calls from W/ Hawkins. W/ Baldwin said he didn't answer his phone, because he was almost home. W/ Baldwin said he drove through the gate and started to turn onto Trailway Dr. W/ Baldwin saw a police unit parked on Trailway Dr near Parkhill. W/ Baldwin said there was a brown Volvo parked directly behind the police unit facing west with two people inside. W/ Baldwin did not think anything of the police unit and went around it continuing towards his residence. W/ Baldwin saw a white police officer standing behind a tree on the south side of the street. W/ Baldwin said the officer had his gun pointed west toward S/ Millon who was standing on the south sidewalk. W/ Baldwin said he hadn't seen S/ Millon yet as he was driving west on Trailway. W/ Baldwin said when he got to the rear of a box truck that was parked on the south side of the street, he saw S/ Millon standing over V/ Bradford pointing a black semi-automatic handgun at her. W/ Baldwin saw S/ Millon fire two shots at a downward angle into V/ Bradford as she was lying on the sidewalk. W/ Baldwin said V/ Bradford was lying near a pickup truck parked in front of 11532 Trailway Dr. W/ Baldwin said he sped towards his residence. W/ Baldwin said after he passed S/ Millon, he looked in his rearview mirror and saw S/ Millon crossing the street (north) towards his residence. W/ Baldwin said he heard approximately three more shots as he was arriving at his house. W/ Baldwin did not see the police officer fire his weapon or hear him giving commands.

W/ Baldwin said W/ Hawkins was standing on the porch of their residence watching the shooting when he arrived at his house. W/ Baldwin said there was a white male that drives a dark Bentley standing in the street watching the shooting. W/ Baldwin did not see anybody else on the street besides W/ Hawkins, the white male near the Bentley and the two people in the brown Volvo. W/ Baldwin came out of his house a short time later and saw officers surrounding the residence. W/ Baldwin said that was the first time he saw the other victim (V/ Conley) lying in the yard. W/ Baldwin didn't have any further information about the shooting, victims or suspect.

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I then contacted W/ Hawkins who was visibly upset about the shooting. W/ Hawkins said she is dating W/ Baldwin and has been living at 11556 Trailway Dr. since last year. W/ Hawkins said she was on the back patio planting some flowers when she heard a bell ringing from a residence to the west. W/ Hawkins said it went on for about 3 minutes and sounded like a school bell. W/ Hawkins said she then heard loud talking followed by someone screaming. W/ Hawkins said a short time after the screams she heard 5-12 gunshots. W/ Hawkins said all of this was coming from the direction of V/ Bradford's residence. W/ Hawkins said there was about a minute and a half pause and then she heard another 5-12 shots coming from the same area. W/ Hawkins said all the shots sounded the same.

W/ Hawkins went out to the front of her house to see what was happening. W/ Hawkins saw a white male standing near a dark Bentley in the street calling 911. W/ Hawkins said she saw a black male in a white t-shirt and jeans down the street east of her house. W/ Hawkins said the white male was telling the black male that he had called the police and to give himself up. W/ Hawkins said she called W/ Baldwin, but he did not answer his phone. W/ Hawkins said the white male continued yelling at the black male to give up and that the police were on the way. W/ Hawkins said the black male turned around in a military type fashion. W/ Hawkins said the black male told the white male, "I'm defending myself." W/ Hawkins said the black male was standing over V/ Bradford on the south sidewalk when he said this to the white male. W/ Hawkins said V/ Bradford was not moving. W/ Hawkins said she did not see the black male fire any shots. She only heard them. W/ Hawkins said W/ Baldwin arrived and she went into the house. W/ Hawkins said they waited a while to go back outside and that was when she saw the other body lying on the grass.

Hawkins said she did not know the victims or the suspect. She did not hear anything said by the suspect other than the comment that he was defending himself to the white male. W/ Hawkins first said she did not see the black male holding anything and then said she possibly saw him holding a weapon. She did not see anyone else on the street besides the white male. W/ Hawkins said she never saw the police and only heard a helicopter above.

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
