Details

On 05-11-11, I attended the autopsy of S-Millon. The autopsy took place at the Riverside County Coroner's Office.

The autopsy began at 1125 hours. It was completed at 1305 hours. Dr. McCormick performed the autopsy.

S-Millon had no clothing on his body. Medical strips and patches were on his chest area.

Physical injuries

S-Millon had the following visible injuries, which were described by Dr. McCormick:

- Possible dog bite to his right side, rib cage area
- Possible dog bite to his left wrist
- Friction / scraping to the chest and face
- Abrasion to left side of head (Possibly from falling to ground after being shot)
- Small abrasion to right wrist (Possibly from being handcuffed)

Bullet wound to right thigh

S-Millon had a two bullet wounds to his right thigh, which were described by Dr. McCormick.

One bullet wound was to the right upper front thigh. The bullet entered near the front of his thigh and traveled in a horizontal direction to the left. The bullet then exited approximately three inches from the same thigh.

One bullet wound was to the right mid thigh. The bullet entered on the right side of his thigh, traveled through the upper leg and exited from the inner right thigh in a horizontal direction.

Dr. McCormick saw two very small bullet fragments in the right leg. It was determined that there was not a need to retrieve them, due to their size.

Bullet wound to head

S-Millon had a single bullet wound to his head, which was described by Dr. McCormick.

The bullet entered on the right side of his head, near the top. The bullet then traveled through the brain and exited on the left side of his head near the top.

Bullet fragments

Dr. McCormick recovered some bullet fragments from the head and right leg. I took possession of the fragments from K. Wilson and later booked them into evidence. Wilson also provided me with a sample of blood from S-Millon. All items were booked into evidence at the Magnolia Station. **It should be noted that K. Wilson wrote "Fragments from left leg" on the evidence bag. I spoke to her and confirmed that the fragments came from the right leg. She said she accidentally wrote "left leg".**

FIREARMS: In those cases where Riverside Police has confiscated a firearm(s) or other deadly weapon(s) into custody pursuant to Penal Code § 12028.5, a petition may be initiated in the Superior Court within 60 days of seizure. (An ex parte petition may be filed to extend the time if necessary). In those instances where a petition is filed pursuant to Penal Code § 12028.5 the Superior Court will determine whether the firearm(s) or other deadly weapon(s) should be returned. When a petition is not filed, the property unit shall obtain a Department of Justice firearms clearance and an authorization for release of the weapon(s) from the assigned case agent. **Under no circumstances will a weapon be released before 5 business days have passed.** Upon receipt of the clearance and authorization for release, the Property Unit will notify the owner by mail to call for an appointment. Inquires regarding the status of the potential release of weapon(s) may be directed to the Police Property Unit by calling (909) 351-6021. Welfare and Institution Code § 8102 mandates police officers confiscate weapons from persons detained under the provisions of Welfare and Institution Code § 5150. Pursuant to Welfare and Institutions Code § 8102, the health care facility must notify the detained individual of the procedure for return of the weapons. See reverse side for release instructions.
