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DETAILS:

On 11-22-13, at about 2327 hours, I was on patrol in the area of Alessandro and Canyon Crest, riding with partner Officer Grey #1444, when we heard over our police radio that another Officer had been involved in a shooting at 1st and Vine. We proceeded to that area with our lights and sirens on, as we got continual updates over the radio. As we got close to the location it became clear that the location of the armed suspect was unknown and a perimeter was being established.

We initially took a perimeter position at Spruce and the tracks, but were later directed to a perimeter position at Franklin and Lyman. After several minutes it was broadcasted that all parties had been accounted for and we could abandon our perimeter locations.

We responded to the scene of the shooting to offer any assistance. I was directed by Sgt. Wilson to try and locate the bullet strikes that were fired from the suspect. He showed me the suspect vehicle and directed me to look in a southwest direction from there. He believed there were 2-3 rounds fired from the suspect in that direction. In checking the area I saw two bullet strikes in police unit # 3934. One strike was in the drivers side mirror and the other was in the drivers door near the A-pillar. I also located a bullet strike in a black Toyota pickup truck that was parked on the west side of the street, in front of 3091 E. La Cadena, license plate #6E19825.

I reported these findings to Sgt. Wilson, who then directed me to contact the residents on the south side of 1st St. between Vine and E. La Cadena. I went to 3112 1st St. and knocked on the door for several minutes. There was no answer at the door, but several vehicles present in the driveway. I checked the exterior of the residence and did not find any signs of bullet strikes. I then went to 3130 1st St. and found the home to be abandoned. I knocked on the door and received no response. I looked in the windows and found no furniture or belongings visible inside. There were no signs of bullet strikes on this residence either.

I reported this back to Sgt. Wilson and was cleared from the scene at approximately 0031 hours.
