Narrative:

On 11-23-13, at approximately 0530 hours, I responded from the Magnolia Station to the scene located at 3020 E. La Cadena Drive, Riverside to assist with the crime scene investigation.

Upon my arrival, I assisted Senior Forensic Technician McKay-Davis with securing, charting and collecting a black revolver (#WM08) that was located on the ground outside the passenger side of the suspect vehicle.

Weapon Information:

Smith & Wesson, .38 Special, Model 143, revolver, Serial #K852842

I put on a new pair of latex gloves and picked up the weapon, which was covered in blood, by the grip. I opened the cylinder and discovered the weapon to be a six (6) shot revolver. The weapon was loaded with three (3) .38 Special +P rounds, two of which been fired. There was a .38 Special round that was also fired. The third .38 Special +P round was not fired. The other two (2) cylinders were empty. Forensic Technician McKay-Davis photographed and documented the weapon and bullet configuration before the rounds were collected. Refer to the photographs for details.

A records check of the weapon identified the purchaser as:



The weapon was not reported / entered as lost or stolen.

I then stood by as Deputy Coroner Ferris and Deputy Coroner Roberts began their initial death investigation on the suspect, identified as Adolfo Ramirez. (Ramirez was tentatively identified by his California Identification Card (# [REDACTED]), which was found in his pants pocket and tattoos. He was positively identified by CAL-ID on 11-23-13). Forensic Technician McKay-Davis was present as well and took photographs for documentation.

Adolfo Ramirez

Ramirez was lying on his stomach and his hands were cuffed behind his back. He was wearing a black leather jacket, striped long-sleeve shirt, grey Nike t-shirt, black jeans, dark belt, grey sweatpants, black socks and blue Vans shoes. The black jacket was torn near the tricep / shoulder and there was white insulation visible. There was possible blood visible on the jacket as well.

Deputy Coroner Ferris conducted a gunshot residue (GSR) collection kit on Ramirez's hands at the scene. Forensic Technician McKay-Davis took possession of the kit and later booked it as evidence (WM17). Ramirez was then uncuffed and the handcuffs were given to McKay-Davis for collection / booking (WM14). Deputy Ferris then removed personal property from the clothing of Ramirez.

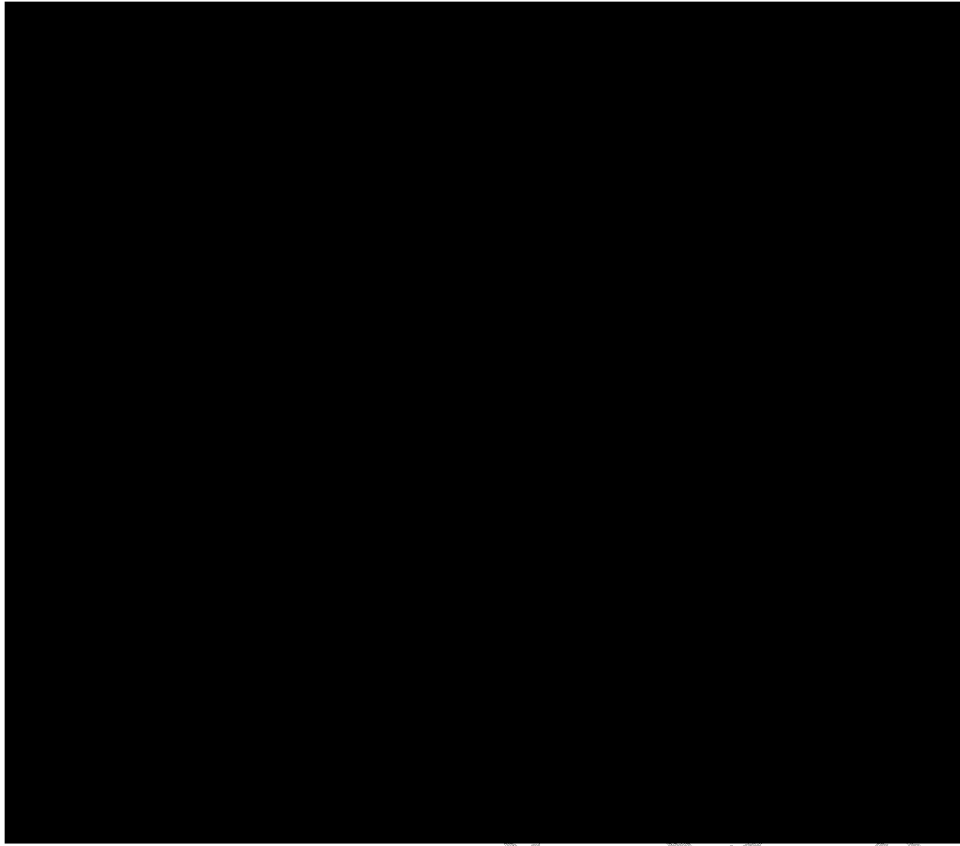
Deputy Ferris removed the black jacket and lifted his shirts, which revealed a single gunshot wound to his left chest. Ramirez had abrasions to his face, along with pieces of asphalt, consistent with the K9 apprehension.

She then took fingernail clippings from both of Ramirez's hands. Forensic Technician McKay-Davis took possession of the nail clippings as evidence (#WM16).

The Sheriff-Coroner's Office took possession of Ramirez's body pending an autopsy. The autopsy is scheduled for 11-25-13 at 0900 hours.
