Narrative of Supplemental Report:

On Wednesday, November 16, 2011 I was assigned as a uniformed police patrol supervisor at the Lincoln Street Station. Just after completing the morning Roll Call Briefing we heard a radio broadcast of an "11-99", officers needing help at about 0737 hours. Sergeant R. Ramirez and I took my assigned car and proceeded to the scene and observed multiple marked police cars arriving simultaneously. We proceeded to the Southwest rear of the complex.

We then established that the initial team of officers that requested the call for help were OK and established a containment perimeter. Due to the nature of this call, I requested Medical Personnel respond to the scene and stage until needed. I saw that civilian citizens were in the complex on foot and in vehicles and I directed Officer M. Tryon to drive through the complex and to make P.A. announcements for residents to remain inside their apartments.

We established that the suspect was barricaded inside a specific apartment and had officers remain in fixed positions maintaining containment. Due to the number of officers on scene, I directed several of them to reposition themselves. Lieutenants G. Leach and L. Phillips then had me go to the Command Post with Sergeant Ramaekers, Detectives L. Ellefson and Rita Cobb and assist with intelligence and logistics gathering. I remained at the Command Post until the situation was rendered safe and I was cleared from the incident by Lieutenant A. Flores.
