Narrative:

On November 16, 2011, at about 0720 hours, I heard a radio broadcast of an "11-99 with shots fired at the apartment complex located at 10406 Indiana Ave. I responded to the scene to assist. I arrived within minutes of the original broadcast.

Upon my arrival, I retrieved the gear that I needed as a first responder and ran into the complex. I met with Sgt. Corbett at the initial command post, which was located on the driveway inside the complex. Sgt. Corbett were briefed on what had happened. We learned that Detectives from the SACA unit were serving a search warrant at apartment #Q-242, when they were involved in a shooting. Sgt. Corbett asked me to begin a scout of the apartment unit and the surrounding area. I began the scout at the position of the arrest team which was positioned just outside apartment #Q-242. I noted their names (Sgt. Payne, Sgt. Ramaekers, Det. Simons, Officers Asbury, Watkins, Hill and Cruz and helped to reposition them where they could have better cover/concealment. I requested an officer with a 40 mm, less lethal launcher to assist at their position. Officer Ortiz handled that responsibility. I noted that the officers on the arrest team had already evacuated the apartment directly across the breezeway (North) from apartment #Q-242. I placed two officers (Officers Glover and Watkins) in that unit in the event that the suspect was able to make it through a wall, into that unit without our knowing. I moved around to the West side of the building to ensure that the apartment unit directly behind #Q-242 was evacuated. I asked the resident of that unit to voluntarily leave. She cooperated. I asked Officers Fishell and E. Garcia to remain at that apartment in the event that the suspect was able to make into there.

I ensured that the south side of the building was contained and went back to the command post to relay the information that I had and what I had done. When SWAT officers arrived, an arrest team was formed and they self-deployed to replace the arrest team that already at the apartment. I replaced Officers Fishell and E. Garcia with SWAT Officers Allison and Asbury. I also sent SWAT Officers Hammer and DeGruy to replace Officers Lindgren and C. Martin, who were set south of the apartment.

I then assisted Sgt. Warren with the scribe duties until the scene was secured and released to the homicide investigators.
