Narrative:

On Wednesday, November 16, 2011, at about 0800 hrs, a full SWAT call-out was initiated. I was advised to respond to 10406 Indiana #Q242 (Tyler Springs) regarding an Officer involved shooting. I was informed that Detectives from the SACA unit attempted to serve a search warrant at the location for a subject identified as S1. Upon entry the Detectives were met with gunfire. Detectives returned fire and managed to exit the apartment. S1 was last seen inside the apartment with a shotgun. S1 was believed to be barricaded inside the apartment. See original report for further details.

At about 0815hrs, Ofc. Goodson and I arrived and checked in with the command post. During our brief time at the command post we were able to obtain a photograph of the suspect, a layout of the apartment and a brief synopsis of the incident.

As more SWAT team personnel arrived we began towards the apartment. Ofc. Goodson and I met with Sgt. Corbett who briefed us on the perimeter and Arrest team personnel. Sgt. Whitt, Ofc. Goodson, Ofc. Castaneda, Ofc. Park, Ofc. Stennett, Ofc. Mercadefe and I moved to apartment #Q243 (directly across the primary apartment) and replace the Arrest team comprised of Ofc. Watkins, Ofc. Glover, and Ofc. Ortiz. From there we could see the front door of the primary apartment. The door was opened and we could only see a couch to the left of the front door and the wall directly across the door opening. Once assignments on the arrest team were delegated, Ofc. Goodson began to make announcements to S1. There was no response from S1.

Due to our limited view and the fact that S1 was possibly inside the apartment armed we decided to use our department assigned "Recon Scout" (small robot with camera). Ofc. Goodson tossed the Recon Scout into the apartment. I used the controller to maneuver the Recon Scout inside the apartment. I maneuvered the RS into the kitchen area (directly to the right of the door). I saw dining chairs toppled on the ground and was prevented from moving forward by a large shotgun on the ground. From this position I was able to point the RS towards the hallway where I saw what appeared to be a person lying on the ground. The distance from the RS to the body and the static on the monitor prevented me from seeing the person in detail. I kept this visual until the TSU robot was able to enter the apartment and get a better visual.

Sgt. McCoy, advised us that the person in the hallway appeared to be S1. S1 was positioned feet towards the front door and lying on his right side. Sgt. McCoy further advised S1's right hand was empty and his left hand was out of view tucked under his body.

With this information, Sgt. Whitt, Ofc. Goodson, Ofc. Park, Ofc. Stennett and I came up with a plan to enter the apartment and clear the apartment a section at a time. Ofc. Goodson entered first followed by Ofc. Castaneda, myself, Ofc. Stennett, Ofc. Park and Sgt. Whitt. When we got to the hallway we could see that S1 was motionless. I covered S1 as Ofc. Goodson, Ofc. Castaneda and Ofc. Park past S1 and entered the two remaining bedrooms. Once the rooms were cleared I reached over and attempted to get S1's pulse. I grabbed his outstretched right wrist and could feel he was cold to the touch and did not have a pulse.

tactical medics A. Hernandez and A. Demole entered the apartment and pronounced S1 deceased. Once the scene was secured we exited the apartment. NFI.
