Source of Activity

On Wednesday November 16, 2011 at approx. 0745 hours a request for the Technical Services Unit (TSU) was requested to the scene of an Officer Involved Shooting at 10406 Indiana Ave (City and County of Riverside) to provide Remote Operated Vehicle (ROV) support. Det. Brandt and I (Det. James Dana #281) responded with the appropriate equipment.

Assisting Personnel

Detective Aaron Brandt #268 Technical Services Unit

Evidence

1. CD of ICOR Remote Operated Vehicle (ROV) video footage.
*Note: Date and Time stamp on the video is not accurate due to the immediate need to deploy the robot which did not allow members of the Technical Services Unit time to correct it.
2. CD of the Robotic Support Vehicle mast camera.

Item #RAG003 was placed into evidence by Officer Glover #1406 and is an expended 12g Blank shell casing that was removed from the ICOR ROV disrupters prior to deployment in to the apartment. The casing was inadvertently left behind in the Technical Services Unit (TSU) Command Post once the operation was completed and turned in to Officer Glover by a concerned citizen. I contacted the Homicide Unit and advised them that the item was not part of the incident and I would be in contact with the Property Unit to have it removed from the Property Log and it would be disposed of in the appropriate manner.

Narrative:

Upon arriving at the location Det. Brandt, Officer Anderson (see his supplemental report for details of his actions) and I began immediately setting up the ROV's to assist as needed. Lt. Gonzalez requested I drive the ICOR ROV to the area of the apartment and to enter the apartment with the ROV and attempt to locate the suspect. The video image I was observing through the ROV was digitally recorded on a DVR during the course of the operation and burned to a CD that was placed into evidence at a later date on November 18, 2011.

I made entry into the apartment through the open front door and after manipulating the ROV around some obstacles (couch, chairs, and shelving units) I was able to observe a shotgun, shell casings, blood, and a smaller ROV (RECON SCOUT) utilized by the METRO Team on the ground in the common area to the left of the kitchen (as seen from the front of the ROV). I was given the go ahead by Sgt. McCoy to continue into the apartment and that the suspect was possibly in the hallway to the left of the front of the ROV. I manipulated the ROV to where I could observe the hallway and saw the suspect was lying face down and his feet were towards the ROV and his head was further down the hallway. I could not detect any movement in the suspect and Sgt. McCoy advised me to move the ROV out of the way so the METRO team could make entry and contact the suspect. I was able to move the ROV in such a manner as to maintain a visual on the suspect as the METRO Team was making the entry. At which time the ROV was no longer a part of the operation. Due to the ongoing investigation into the incident the ROV remained inside the apartment.

At approx. 1055 hrs I entered the scene to turn off the ROV and disarm the weapons to allow the appropriate personnel to conduct the investigation into the incident safely. At approx. 1637 hrs Det. Brandt and I returned to the scene to recover the ROV and remove it from the scene. I also recovered the

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RECON SCOUT ROV from the scene at the same time. Det. Brandt and I returned to the Technical Services Unit Office and decontaminated the ROV's which had been contaminated with blood from the scene.

On November 17, 2011 Det. Brandt downloaded the video footage from the ROV and the Robotic Support Vehicle mast camera and burned the video to CD's and I placed those videos into evidence at the Lincoln Station on 11-18-11.
