Detective Ellefson advised me she had recalled additional information a short time after the incident and her interview took place. Detective Ellefson said it is in reference to her bullet magazine change. Detective Ellefson advised that during the time she looked over the sofa and observed S-Romo fall to the ground is when she realized her handgun had locked. Detective Ellefson said she wasn't sure if she had fired all her bullets or her gun had jammed so she removed her bullet magazine from her handgun. Detective Ellefson stated as she went to reload she realized she hadn't worn her extra bullet magazine pouch. Detective Ellefson advised she yelled to Detective Fernandez that she needed a bullet magazine for her weapon. Detective Ellefson said she isn't sure if Detective Fernandez heard her because he was yelling at her that they needed to get out of the apartment. Detective Ellefson stated she agreed it was a good time due to the fact that S-Romo had gone to the ground. Detective Ellefson advised after she and Detective Fernandez were on the sidewalk behind the patio wall of S-Romo's apartment she was given a bullet magazine from Detective Fernandez. NFI
