Narrative

On 11-16-11 I responded to an officer involved shooting (OIS) at the listed address. One of my assigned duties was to chart the weapons of the Investigators that were present during the incident. This charting took place at the Magnolia Police Station in the evidence unit's office.

All of the officers were photographed with the equipment they were carrying and in the clothing they were wearing at the time of the incident. None of them were carrying digital recorders and no recorders were recovered from their persons. The following are the results of the charting. See the weapons charting sheets in Evidence Tech Fullers supplemental report for details:

Det Riso-Ellefson

Det Ellefson was carrying a Department issued .40 caliber Glock model 23 handgun loaded with (13) live .40 caliber rounds in the magazine with no round chambered. She had no spare magazines.

She also had a back-up .357 Airlight Revolver which was fully loaded with (5) live .38 rounds in an ankle holster on her left ankle.

Det Fernandez

Det Fernandez was carrying a Department issued .40 caliber Glock model 23 handgun fully loaded with (13) live .40 caliber rounds in the magazine and (1) round chambered. He was carrying one spare magazine which contained (4) live .40 caliber rounds.

Sgt Ramaekers

Sgt Ramaekers was carrying a Department issued .40 caliber Glock model 22 handgun loaded with (13) live .40 caliber rounds in the magazine and (1) in the chamber. He had two spare magazines on his belt which were fully loaded with (15) rounds each.

Det Cobb

Det Cobb was carrying a personally owned 9mm Glock model 26 handgun fully loaded with (10) live 9mm rounds in the magazine and (1) round in the chamber. She was carrying one spare magazine fully loaded with (10) live rounds.

Det Jones

Det Jones was carrying a .40 caliber Glock model 27 handgun fully loaded with (9) live rounds in the magazine and (1) round in the chamber. He had no spare magazines for this weapon.

He also had a department issued .40 caliber Glock model 22 handgun which was loaded with (14) live .40 caliber rounds in the magazine and (1) round chambered. He had two spare magazines fully loaded with (15) rounds each.

Sgt Ramaekers, Det Riso-Ellefson and Det Fernandez's weapons and magazines were collected and new weapons were issued to them by Sgt Russell. Only the weapons which were suspected of being fired or possibly had been fired were taken. This information was determined by their statements to Investigators and the charting.
