3 RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 21322
4 TO REVISE THE PARKING RATE AND HOUR SCHEDULE TO
5 PROVIDE FOR NEW PARKING PROGRAMS, RATES, AND
6 HOURS OF OPERATION.

8 forth the Downtown Parking Rate and Hour Schedule for the various Municipal Parking
9 Facilities within the Downtown area; and


21 WHEREAS, the City desires to further amend Resolution No. 21322 to provide for

27 programs, rates, and hours of operation.


28 Section 2: That the Parking Rate and Hour Schedule is hereby revised in its entirety as


