**INTERVIEW WITH JUSTIN RESCORN**

**Q=Ofc. James Heiting**

**A=Justin Rescorn**

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Q: All right. What was your name again?

A: Justin Rescorn.

Q: All right, Justin, I just need to run it by just in case something jogs your memory, ah, just get some detailed information. Okay, so you live at, ah, 7850 Cypress. Is that right?

A: Yep.

Q: And it's Apartment Number 9301.

A: Yes.

Q: Is that correct? Okay. And so you're the one that called it in?

A: Mm-hm.

Q: You called into 911?

A: Yeah.

Q: Okay. So, why did you call 911?

A: He was freaking out in the road and I was afraid he was gonna get hit and, ah, my neighbor had come out and suggest that I call the police. Let it go for a minute or two.

Q: Okay. You know this guy or...

A: My neighbor or the guy who was screaming?

Q: The guy that was screaming?

46 A: No, never seen him before.

48 Q: And you - and you say black male, white male, Hispanic male?  
49  
50 A: I'm - I would say the guy is Hispanic.  
51  
52 Q: Hispanic. Okay. And you remember what he was wearing?  
53  
54 A: Yeah.  
55  
56 Q: What was he wearing?  
57  
58 A: Dark blue shirt, jeans, light colored shoes.  
59  
60 Q: Okay. So he's screaming in the middle of the street. You thought hey this  
61 guy's...  
62  
63 A: Well he started getting pretty close to getting hit by cars and people do not  
64 slow down for people in the street...  
65  
66 Q: Right. Okay, so he was almost hit by a car.  
67  
68 A: Yeah, you know, and then he started stopping traffic and yelling, kill me - kill  
69 me. I was like, I don't know, like I figured he's either a crazy guy or somebody  
70 that had too much to drink, you know.  
71  
72 Q: Okay. And at what point did you call 911? Was it before that or after that?  
73  
74 A: Ah, right when he started walking out in the traffic. I was, yeah, I better call.  
75  
76 Q: Okay. And what did you tell the dispatcher?  
77  
78 A: That there was some crazy guy standing in the street screaming and that you  
79 guys might wanna get someone over and he's gonna stop the traffic. I had it on  
80 speaker phone so she would hear it all, him screaming and hollerin'.  
81  
82 Q: Oh, okay. So you were close enough for the - for the dispatcher to hear it fine.  
83  
84 A: Yeah. He was about pretty much right where we are standing so you heard it...  
85  
86 Q: Okay. So you're right out front at 7850 Cypress?  
87  
88 A: Yeah.  
89

90 Q: And he was in the middle of the road. How - how many feet away do you  
91 think?  
92  
93 A: Ah, feet, 100 feet.  
94  
95 Q: What does that look like to you?  
96  
97 A: Maybe 100, 120 feet maybe?  
98  
99 Q: 120 feet?  
100  
101 A: Yeah. The guy was right about like where you're standing. Right there and  
102 yelling something couldn't understand and he hit that car with something.  
103 And, ah...  
104  
105 Q: Okay. So he threw an object at that car?  
106  
107 A: Yeah. It looked like maybe a suitcase. I don't know it was about that big and  
108 square.  
109  
110 Q: Okay.  
111  
112 A: And, ah, he started yelling and then some lady ran out in the middle of the  
113 road right before you guys showed up and looked like she was trying to get  
114 him out of there - out of the street. That didn't work.  
115  
116 Q: It didn't work?  
117  
118 A: No. He kinda pushed her off and then...  
119  
120 Q: Then he stayed in the middle of the street.  
121  
122 A: Yeah - yeah. And then you guys showed up less than a minute after that.  
123  
124 Q: Okay. So within minutes of you calling, we arrived. He' still out in the middle  
125 of the street.  
126  
127 A: Yeah.  
128  
129 Q: Okay. And then what happened after that?  
130  
131 A: Ah, after you guys showed up, ah, the helicopter hit the spotlight on him and  
132 the police officers came right - I guess - I think it's actually that car right there  
133 and they approached him and he tensed up and, ah, one of the officers took  
134 out his night stick and he felt he needed to hit that cop 'cause he tried...

136 Q: Okay.  
137  
138 A: ...and it didn't work out for him.  
139  
140 Q: Okay.  
141  
142 A: So he swung at...  
143  
144 Q: Do you remember which one it was with you? You could see hair color or  
145 anything like that?  
146  
147 A: Ah, dark hair color. It - it was kinda from the back, you know...  
148  
149 Q: Okay. It's not that easy to tell.  
150  
151 A: Yeah, but he had a full head of hair...  
152  
153 Q: Okay.  
154  
155 A: ...can't tell which officer that was.  
156  
157 Q: So he looked like he swung at him.  
158  
159 A: Yeah.  
160  
161 Q: Did the officer go down or what happened?  
162  
163 A: No. He didn't actually hit the officer. The - the officer kinda ducked under it  
164 and hit him in the leg and then he tried to swing again and that's when the -  
165 the second officer came into the mix.  
166  
167 Q: Okay.  
168  
169 A: He just kinda beat the crap out of him a little bit and...  
170  
171 Q: Now was he going down or was he swinging? What was he doing?  
172  
173 A: They had him on the ground but he was still bucking, trying to get up and so  
174 they were hitting him like on the back and stuff like that. They, ah, I saw the  
175 taser go off. (Unintelligible).  
176  
177 Q: Okay, so what's the taser look like?  
178  
179 A: Ah, it kinda looks like a pistol but you - you can hear and see the sparks...

180  
181 Q: Okay.  
182  
183 A: ...you know.  
184  
185 Q: Okay. So he was just struggling at this point (unintelligible).  
186  
187 A: Oh yeah, well even after they shocked him, he was still fightin' it like right up  
188 until the ambulance showed up, he was still kinda buckin' 'em.  
189  
190 Q: Okay.  
191  
192 A: He was...  
193  
194 Q: And did you see where his hands were goin'? Did you see anything like did he  
195 have contact with the officers?  
196  
197 A: I think they had him pretty restrained for the most part. He was just like...  
198  
199 Q: This was after?  
200  
201 A: Yeah, after they had him down, he's just kinda of a big guy. You know, he  
202 kept trying to get up.  
203  
204 Q: Okay. So he was putting his hands down on the ground trying to get up?  
205  
206 A: Um, I just, ah, - ah - ah dog pile and headin' on the bottom trying to push up  
207 and...  
208  
209 Q: Okay.  
210  
211 A: ....they're not letting him.  
212  
213 Q: Okay. Did you see the officers strugglin' to get a hold of 'em?  
214  
215 A: Ah, no but I'm assuming they got his arms...  
216  
217 Q: Okay.  
218  
219 A: ...they were on their knees.  
220  
221 Q: Okay. And then what happened after that?  
222  
223 A: The ambulance came. He was kinda chilled out after the second or third cop  
224 car showed up and...
